Office Memorandum

Subject: - Payment of arrear to Pre-2006 Pensioners/Family Pensioners on account of revision of Pension/Family Pension w.e.f. 01-01-2006.

In continuation of this Department's Office Memorandum of even number dated the 29th March, 2010 vide which 10% of the Pension / Family Pension arrears accrued to Pre-2006 Pensioners/Family Pensioners w.e.f. 01-01-2006 to 30-09-2009 due to revision of pension / family pension, was ordered to be paid as per para-2 of the aforesaid O.M. dated 29-03-2010, the undersigned is directed to say that the Governor, Himachal Pradesh, is now pleased to order the payment of additional 10% of the arrears of pension / family pension arrears after making necessary adjustments as stated in para 2 below. Thus, the total cumulative arrears released so far after taking into account the present release, shall amount to 20% of the total arrears accrued to the Pre-2006 Pensioners/ Family Pensioners.

2. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd installments of Interim Relief already paid vide this Department's O.M. Nos. Fin (Pen)B(10)-6/98-II dated 7.3.2008, 18.10.2008 & O. M. No. Fin(Pen)B(10)-6/98-III dated 28-1-2009 and five installments of Dearness Relief sanctioned earlier vide O.M. No. Fin (Pen) B (10)-6/98-II dated 21.11.2006, 15.6.2007, 30.10.2007, 19.8.2008 and 25.11.2008 respectively (also refer para 4.6 of this Department O.M. No. Fin

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(Pen) A (3)-1/09-II dated 14-10-2009) are required to be adjusted against the pension/family pension arrears. Besides, Dearness Relief @ of 6% and 5% paid to the pensioners/family pensioners w.e.f. 1.1.2009 and 1.7.2009 respectively upto 30.9.2009 referred to in para- 9 of this Department O.M. No. Fin (Pen) B (10)-6/98-III dated 14.10.2009 will also be adjusted from the amount of the above said arrears. In case the amount of pension/family pension arrears as stated in para 1 above is not sufficient to adjust the amount of Interim Relief and Dearness Relief already paid and any amount still remains to be adjusted, the same shall be adjusted against the future release of pension arrears/family pension arrears and Dearness Relief.

3. It shall be the responsibility of Pension Disbursing Authorities including Public Sector Banks to ensure that the entire amounts are adjusted as stated above at the earliest from the arrears and the balance amount only may be paid to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners.




