Subject:- Calculation of Contribution towards the Contributory Pension Scheme on
arrears of Pay, Interim Relief and Dearness allowance.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to Rule 4(1) & (2) of Himachal Pradesh
Civil Services Contributory Pension Rules, 2006 which provides that employees
covered by the scheme shall be required to pay a monthly contribution, which would be
10% of the Basic Pay, Dearness Pay, D.A. & NPA, to the Contributory Pension Scheme,
and a matching contribution equal to employees contribution would be made by the
State Government every month. The Himachal Pradesh Government has also granted
Interim Relief w.e.f. 1-11-2006 to its employees vide Office Memorandum
Fin.(PR)B(7)-2/2006, dated 7th March 2008 which has been treated as pay for the
purpose of payment of Dearness Allowance etc.

2 It has come to the notice of this department that some Drawing & Disbur
Officers have not made deductions (@) 10% on account of contribution towards Contribu
Pension Fund from the Interim Relief/Dearness Allowance arrears and neither are
effecting recovery from the salary bills on the enhanced amount arising out of paymen
Interim Relief and revised Dearness allowance etc., which is contrary to the provision of
Rules.

3. It is, therefore requested that all the Drawing & Disbursing Officers under
your control may please be directed to work out the revised contribution
towards Contributory Pension Fund (@) 10% of Basic Pay, Dearness Pay, Interim
Relief, Dearness Allowance & NPA, sanctioned by the Government, from time to
time. The necessary deductions/recoveries may also be made from the arrears and

monthly salary bills, in cases where the same has not been done.
