OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Clarification regarding commutation of pension of post 2006 retirees.

I am directed to say that in accordance with instruction contained in this department's O.M. No. Fin(Pen)A(3)1/09-Part-I dated 14-10-2009, in the case of those pensioners, in whose case the commutation of pension become absolute on or after 1-1-2006 but before the issue of that O.M., the pre revised Table of Commutation Value for pension will be used for payment of commutation of pension based on pre-revised pay/pension. Such pensioners shall have an option to commute the amount of pension that has become additionally commutable on account of retrospective revision of pay/pension. On exercising such an option by the pensioner, the revised Table of Commutation Value for Pension will be used for the commutation of the additional amount of pension that has become commutable on account of retrospective revision of pay/pension.

Some references have been received in this Department seeking clarification in regard to various issues relating to commutation of pension in case a pensioner opts for commutation of pension that has become additionally commutable on account of retrospective revision of pay/pension.. The matter has been examined and following clarifications are issued in this regard.

	Point raised	Clarification
1.	What would be the age to be used for commutation of additional commutable pension and which factor would be used for such additional commuted value of pension?	The age reckoned for calculation of commuted value of pension at the time of original application for commutation of pension will apply for calculation of commutation value of additional commutable pension, However as mentioned in O.M. (Part-I) dated 14.10.2009, the commutation factor in revised Table of Commutation Value for Pension will be used for commutation of the additional amount of pensions that has

		become commutable on account of retrospective revision of pay/pension.
2.	From which date the reduction in pension on account of additional commutation of pension will take effect?	Reduction in pension on account of additional commutation of pension will be in two stages as per provisions contained in Rule 6 of CCS (Commutation of pension) Rules, 1981.
3.	What will be the date of restoration of additional commutation of pension?	The Commuted portion of pension shall be restored after 15 years from the respective dates of commutation as provided in Government of India decision No-1 under Rule 10 of CCS (Commutation of Pension) Rules 1981. Necessary endorsement should be made in P.P.O.

It is impressed upon all ADs/HODs/HOO of Government of H.P. to keep in view the above clarifications while disposing cases of commutation of additional pension.
