OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject :

Grant of Dearness Allowance to the employees of
the State Government w.e.f. 1.7.1999.

In continuation to this Department's Office Memorandum of even number dated 27th May 1999, the Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to order that the rates of the Dearness Allowance payable to the employees of the Government of Himachal Pradesh shall stand modified as under :

7.1999

37% of pay.

2. The term "PAY" for the purpose of calculation of Dearness Allowance, shall remain the same as defined in para 2 of this Department O.M. of even number dated 27th May, 1999 and in respect of such employees who have opted to retain pre-revised pay scales or whose scales have not yet been revised, the term "PAY" shall be the same as defined in para 2 and note below para 2 of this Department O.M. of even number dated 8th November, 1999.

3. The admissible Dearness Allowance shall be paid in cash w.e.f. 1.4.2000 and the arrears accrued from 1st July, 1999 to 31st March, 2000 shall be credited to the General Provident Fund Accounts of the employees and interest thereon shall accrue from 1st May, 2000. The entire credited amount will be held back for one year.

4. In case of such Government employees who are not eligible to subscribe to the Provident Fund, the drawal of arrears shall be deferred till Provident Fund Account is opened in his/her name OR the arrears may be paid through purchase of National Small Savings Certificates of an amount equal to the nearest Rs. 100/- and the balance amount may be paid in cash. The option of waiting till a GPF account is available or purchase of NSS



certificates may be given to such employees. Government employees, who have retired or have closed their G.F. Accounts by the time the arrears are drawn, shall be paid the arrears in cash.

5. Other terms and conditions as specified in para 6, 7, 8 and 9 of this Department O.M. of even number date 27th May, 1999 shall remain unchanged.
