In continuation of this Department's letter of even number dated 09<sup>th</sup> May, 2006 on the above subject, it is clarified that the maximum ceiling for emoluments for the persons to be engaged on contract basis would be the initial of the pay scale of the category concerned plus dearness pay @ 50% of it thereon. In no case, it should exceed this prescribed limit fixed by this Department. These orders will be applicable to all those working in the various Government Departments.

## Subject: Contractual appointments - Emoluments thereof.

In continuation of this department's letter of even numbers dated 9.5.06 and 17.5.06 on the subject cited above. I am directed to say that consequent upon issuance of the above model guidelines of determination of emoluments of people appointed on contract basis, it came to light that different departments were following different formulations: While some were still paying on pre-revised grades, others were allowing allowances on the revised pay scales.

issues reported to the Finance Department on the impact of the order dated 9.5.06, the issue of grant of emoluments to the contractual employees in different departments has been reconsidered and the following is hereby clarified:

- That the contractual appointees appointed before 9.5.06 will be asked to exercise an option stating clearly as to whether they would like to be governed by the terms and conditions of their contract as already executed and in operation before 9.5.06 or they would like to opt to be governed by the order dated 9.5.06. In case they opt to be governed by the order dated 9.5.06, their emoluments will be determined strictly as per emoluments shown in letter dated 9.5.06. This is being done only to ensure that the letter dated 9.5.06 does not adversely affect the total emoluments drawn by any individual prior to the issuance of the above orders.
- 2. However, employees opting to be governed by the pattern prior to 9.5.06 individually determined for them under the contract, they shall dontinue to get emoluments as admissible to them prior to 9.5.06 and the orders dated 9.5.06 shall not be operative on them.
- 3. It may be noted, however that all new appointments (after 9.5.05) shall be governed as per instructions dated 9<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2006.
- 4. Further, rates mentioned in orders dated 9.5.06 shall be deemed to be the maximum ceiling for Societies and Autonomous Bodies which will be at liberty to give lower salary depending upon their specific market situations.

Reeping in view the above all contract employees may be afforded an opportunity to opt either to continue to draw the contractual amount admissible as ger the terms and conditions already settled or they may opt to come over to the new contractual amount determined by the Government vide orders dated 9.5.06.

TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE TO THE EMPLOYEES APPOINTED ON CONTRACT BASIS.

Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference to the subject mentioned above and to say, that orders have been issued by the State Government for time to time for regulating entitlements of Travelling Allowance in respect of regular State Government employees. For some time past, keeping in view the requirements, a good number of contract appointments are also being made in almost all the departments. These contract employees are required to undertake touring for official purposes, keeping in view exigencies of public service. References / queries are being received from some quarters with regard to entitlements of these contractual employees.

Matter has been examined / considered in Finance Department and it is clarified that in case, the employees appointed on contract basis are required to undertake tour(s) for official work, they will be entitled for TA/DA at same rate as is admissible to their regular counterparts at the minimum of the pay scale of post against which they

have been appointed on contract basis. A condition to this effect may also invariably be incorporated in the terms & conditions of their appointment and contract agreement.
