- The Class-IV employee engaged in E-Governance Society be absorbed in the establishment of concerned Deputy Commissioners against the vacant post of Class-IV on daily wage basis as per prevailing policy.
- Absorption will strictly be made in accordance with their length of service in the view of provisions as contained in the R&P rules.
