 - Question (3): An officer was granted annual increment on 01.12.2009 in the Pay Band 3 of Rs.10300-34800 plus Grade Pay of Rs. 5400 raising his pay from Rs. 23640 to Rs. 24520 plus Grade pay of Rs.5400, was promoted to the post carrying the duties and responsibilities of greater importance in the pay scale of Rs.15600-39100 plus Grade Pay of Rs.6600 in Pay Band 4 on 20.09.2010. He has opted to fix his pay in the higher grade after earning his annual increment in the lower grade. (a) Fix his pay in the higher grade as per option and (b) direct in the higher grade if he has not exercised the option for fixation of pay. (20 marks)
