Q.No.1 Mr.X while working an Accountant in the office of Civil Supplies Corporation short accounted for an amount of Rs.2.00 lakh on account of sale proceeds of PDS items. The matter was reported by the Depot holder to the Managing Director, H.P. State civil Supplies Corporation. In the mean time, Mr X deposited the amount of Rs.2.00 lakh in the Corporations account. The amount of Rs. 2.00 Lakh, however, remained un-accounted for a period of ten months.

Assuming that you are working as Section Officer in the office of Managing Director, Civil Supplies Corporation and have been assigned the job of conducting preliminary enquiry into the matter besides suggesting measures to avoid such recurrences in future. You are required to draft a preliminary enquiry report suggesting therein the charges which should be levelled against the delinquent officer, documents/witness which could be relied upon to substantiate the charges and also suggest measures to avoid such recurrence.

Q.No.2 The substantive pay of Mr.K in the pay band of Rs. 10,300-34,800+ grade Pay of Rs. 4400/- is Rs. 16240/-P.M. with increment on 1st November every year. He is appointed to officiate in a post in the pay band of Rs. 10,300-34,800+ Grade pay of Rs. 5,000/- on 1.05.2015 for a period of two months and then reverted back to his position, He was again promoted to the same higher post w.e.f. 1.10.2015 on regular basis. Fix his pay from time to time.

- a. Claim for T.A. in respect of journeys undertaken to procure health certificate on first appointment was objected by the audit.
- b. T.A. to an employee for appearing in an enquiry against him was allowed.
- c. Advance of T.A in case of journeys performed after retirement was denied.
- d. GPF subscription deducted from subsistence allowance.

- Second penalty was imposed by the competent authority during the currency of the first penalty.

The bill was also verified for payment by the Junior Engineer and test check certificates for hidden items of work were also recorded on the Measurement book by the said Junior Engineer. While the bill was under process, Pradhan of the concerned Gram Panchayat made a complaint alleging that the work in question has actually not been executed.

Draft a charge sheet assuming that you are working as Section Officer in Rural Development Department indicating specifically the charges that you will propose to be levelled against the delinquent officer.
