With this the total number of services available under e-District has reached 31 which ranks the state among top five states in the country.

As part of e-District project, wherever required, the application is integrated with Land Records database to fetch necessary Land details or Family details of the applicant. Similarly, the single sign-on portal of Lok Mitra Kendra is integrated with Land Records, eSamadhan, Employment Exchange portal and Jail Varta applications of NIC Himachal Pradesh.
