In continuation of the letter of even no. dated 22.02.2019 communicating approval of the competent authority for sanction of the Sub-Scheme/ Component 'Strengthening of District Disaster Management Authorities (DDMAs) of Hazard Prone Districts out of the 115 identified backward districts', under the approved Scheme "Improving Disaster Risk Governance at SDMAs/ DDMAs level" of "Other Disaster Management Programme (ODMP)" under the Umbrella Central Sector Scheme - Other Disaster Management Scheme (ODMS) and sanction letter of even number dated 22.02.2019 for part payment of first instalment, I am directed to convey sanction of the competent authority for release of Rs. 4,20,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Twenty Thousand Only) to State Government of Himachal Pradesh as remaining amount of first instalment for implementation of the Scheme - 'Strengthening of District Disaster Management Authorities (DDMAs) of Hazard Prone Districts out of the 115 identified backward districts' for 12 months from 2018 – 19.

- 5. The State Government/ Implementing Agency of the Scheme are also requested to submit a Utilization Certificate in the proforma (Form 12 C) prescribed under GFR, 2017 to the NDMA in respect of utilization of funds.
- 6. This sanction issues in exercise of the powers conferred on NDMA and with the concurrence of Finance Division vide File No. 1-5/2018-PP dated 27.03.2019.
