Sir.

I am directed to convey the sanction of President of India for incurring an expenditure of Rs.3,60,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs and sixty thousand only) during 2018-19 as Grants-in-aid for organizing a 2 days Regional Training Workshop in Shimla for the officers from 5 States/UTs (Jammu & Kashmir, Haryana, Punjab, Chandigarh and Himachal Pradesh) on the procedure for collection of information in 6th Minor Irrigation Census with Reference Year 2017-18 and Census of Water Bodies.

- 2. This fund is to be utilized to meet the following expenses relating to the Regional Training Workshop:
 - i. Suitable venue for the training for two days.
 - ii. Tea with snacks in the forenoon & afternoon and lunch for two days.
 - iii. Backdrop banner and banner outside venue complex
 - iv. Laptop, projector, screen and sound system.
 - v. Training material with pen and slip pad in a folder for the participants.
 - vi. Suitable accommodation for stay of the participants.
 - vii. Transport for pick up and drop of participants as per requirement.
 - viii. Transport for field training to all the participants in some nearby village and urban area.
- 3. The Training Workshop will be organized by Directorate of Land Records, Government of Himachal Pradesh declared as the Nodal Department by the State Government for the purpose.
- 4. The State Government should ensure that the overall cost for the Regional Training Workshop is limited to the amount provided in this sanction, or the actual expenditure whichever is less. State Government should ensure that austerity measures stipulated by the Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, provisions under GFR, DFPRs and directions of MoF/CVC are strictly adhered to (while organizing the Workshop). To the extent possible, transport arrangements may be made for the group and individual vehicles restricted to bare minimum.
- 5. The grants to the State Government of Himachal Pradesh may be released through Central Accounts Section (CAS), Nagpur in accordance with the latest instructions of the Ministry of Finance on this subject.
- 6. The amount of Rs.3,60,000/- (Rupees Three lakhs and sixty thousand only) is debitable to Major Head 3601.06.101.35.07.31 Grants-in-aid to State Governments under Demand No.: 97 Ministry of Water Resources, River Development & Ganga Rejuvenation for the current financial year 2018-19.

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- The payment of the grant amount sanctioned above is provisional and is subject to adjustments in future releases on the basis of actual expenditure duly supported by Utilization Certificate (in format GFR 12-C as per Rule 239 of GFR 2017) countersigned by the Administrative Secretary of the Department regulating the Scheme / Finance Secretary initially and audited figures of expenditure to be furnished by the Accountant General.
- As per Rule 236 (1) of GFR 2017, the accounts of all Grantee Institutions or Organizations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Ministry.
- 9. This sanction is in accordance with Monthly Expenditure Plan (MEP) and Quarterly Expenditure Plan (QEP) ceilings.
- 10. The expenditure is also subject to posting of expenditure on PFMS and directions of Ministry of Finance in relation to PFMS and Treasury Single Accounts (TSA) and guidelines in relation to autonomous bodies for EAT module, as may be applicable
- The Utilization Certificate of this Grants may be submitted to Government of India within 12 months of the closure of current financial year.
- It is certified that the Utilization certificate of funds released earlier has been obtained and Rs.0/- is left unspent with the State Government of Himachal Pradesh under the above Scheme.
