
Sub: Applicable rate of interest for the National Compensatory Afforestation Fund and State Compensatory Afforestation Fund for the year 2022-23 regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to O.M. No. 1(9)-B(AC)/2017 dated 19.09.2022 of Ministry of Finance, Department. of Economic Affairs (Budget Division) on the subject cited above fixing the rate of interest on 'National Compensatory Afforestation Fund' at 3.35% per annum for the financial year 2022-23. Further, as regards the applicable rate of interest for 'State Compensatory Afforestation Fund', Ministry of Finance, Deptt. of Economic Affairs (Budget Division) through their OM 1(1(9)-B(AC)/2017 dated 24.11.2020 have advised this Ministry to notify the same based on the rate of interest applicable for 'National Compensatory Afforestation Fund'.

The above advice has been considered in this Ministry and with the approval of Hon'ble Minister, Environment, Forest and Climate Change, the rate of interest on 'State Compensatory Afforestation Fund' are also fixed at 3.35% per annum for the year 2022-2023.
