

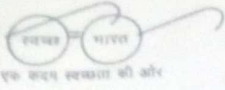

Dear Shri Arun,

India has one of the largest and diverse education systems in the world. Widespread expansion, increased autonomy and introduction of programmes in new and emerging areas have improved access to higher education. At the same time, it has also led to widespread concern on the quality of higher education in today's global scenario.

2. National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) is mandated to make quality assurance an integral part of the functioning of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs). NAAC conducts assessment and accreditation of HEIs, including Colleges, Universities or other recognised institutions, to derive an understanding of the 'Quality Status' of the institution. It evaluates the institutions for their conformance to the standards of quality.

3. From the accreditation status received from NAAC, it is observed that in the State of Himachal Pradesh, out of the total 23 universities, only 7 universities are NAAC accredited and out of the total 327 colleges, only 56 colleges are NAAC accredited.

4. You would appreciate that NAAC accreditation would help higher educational Institutions to recognise their strengths, identify weaknesses and look for opportunities which will further help them in better planning of resources for improvement of quality. You may, therefore, like to check at your end and make efforts to ensure accreditation of the non-accredited Universities/Colleges in your State.
