Subject: Providing of reservation to the distinguished Sports-Persons in various services under the Government.

Sir,

Jai Hind.

I am directed to say that in order to encourage the sportsmen taking part in International, National and inter-State Tournaments, the matter regarding providing of reservation in services to the distinguished sportspersons was under active consideration of the Government for some time past. After careful consideration, it has now been decided that henceforth 3% reservation will be provided to the distinguished sports-persons in the posts/services to be filled in by direct recruitment as under:-

A. EXTENT OF RESERVATION.

i) 3% reservation in direct recruitment posts in Class-III and Class-IV categories in all the State Government Departments, Boards, Corporations and Autonomous Bodies other than High Court, Himachal Pradesh Administrative Tribunal, Governor's Secretariat, Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission and Himachal Pradesh Vidhan Sabha, will be provided under Article 16(1) of the Constitution which will be treated as "Horizontal Reservation".

ii) 3% reservation to the defined categories with respect of Class-I and Class-II posts in the following Departments :-

- Department of Youth Services & Sports.
- Institute of Mountaineering and Allied Sports, Manali.
- Home Guards.
- School Cadre DPE and PET.
- College Cadre Lecturers in Physical Education.

The Government may with the approval of Cabinet and in consultation with HPPSC appoint distinguished sports-persons of category I, II and selective sports-persons in category III to Class I & II posts in departments, boards, corporations, autonomous bodies other than those mentioned above. These appointments will, however, be limited to 3% of the vacancies.

iii) 3% reservation in Class-I and Class-II in other departments will be given in special cases specifically approved by the Council of Ministers.

**B. ELIGIBILITY:-**

Sportspersons participating in games as per Annexure(A) and falling within categories I to IV of Annexure(B) will be the distinguished sportspersons. Sportspersons falling in these categories only will be eligible to claim benefit of reservation.

**C. REGULATION OF RESERVATION:**

- a) Distinguished sportspersons will have to fulfil educational and other professional Qualifications prescribed for the post.
- b) Department of Youth Services & Sports will act as nodal agency for implementation of reservation in all classes of posts.
- c) The sports persons belonging to category-I will be eligible for direct employment in various government departments/Boards/Corporations etc. against reserved posts. The interested department will be free to offer employment directly without any interview or any other formality. This offer will, however, have to be made within one month of winning of medal. In case no department comes forward, the Director, Youth Services & Sports will sponsor name to any department against any post available under sports quota depending upon the suitability and choice of the candidate.
- d) The Department of Youth Services & Sports will set up a Sports Person Employment Cell and maintain a live register with respect of all eligible sports-persons. The Department of Youth Services & Sports will frame rules and guidelines for determining the priority etc. and choice and suitability of

each candidate. The recruiting departments will send requisition to the Department of Youth Services & Sports for sponsoring names against sports quota whenever recruitment is to be made. The Sports Person Recruitment Cell will sponsor one name per vacancy from live register according to priority as per rules from category I, II & III. The requisitioning department will then have to recruit that person only. In case, no suitable candidate is available in category I, II & III, the Sports Person Employment Cell will issue non-availability certificate.

e) After non-availability certificate is obtained for categories I, II & III, the recruiting department will be free to fill up the sports vacancy out of categories IV through H.P. Public Service Commission/ Subordinate Staff Selection Board or Departmental Recruitment Committee in accordance with the recruitment procedure laid down but they will give preference in category IV to Gold Medal winner over Silver medal winner and Silver Medal winner over Bronze Medal winner. The relaxation regarding employment exchange will be applicable and so there will be no need for getting the names sponsored from employment exchange. The recruiting departments will try to involve Youth Services & Sports Department at the time of recruitment against sports quota. In case the vacancy is not advertised through media by recruiting agency, requisition will be sent to the Department of Youth Services & Sports who will sponsor candidates from category IV.

f) With respect to categories I and II or selective outstanding sports persons from category III, the Department of Youth Services & Sports, if need be, will present proposals before Council of Ministers for providing jobs against Class I & II posts in various departments, but in no case will such appointments exceed 3% of the total posts in that department. This will be done in consultation with H.P. Public Service Commission. This provision will be particularly used for sports-persons with professional qualifications who do not fit into posts defined in A (ii) above.

e) The distinguished sports-persons who have participated in recognised sports events i.e. Olympics, Commonwealth and Asian Games and the distinguished sports persons who have been awarded Gold Medal in National Games will be eligible for availing reservation in PET, DPE school cadre and lecturers in Physical Education provided they fulfil the minimum educational qualifications provided for the post. The participation in national events and winning of Gold Medal in National Games will be treated at par with professional qualification required for these posts. In case, it is required, such candidates will undergo in service professional training.

h) The recruiting department will have a right to specify the sports for which they want candidates so that they have competitive teams.

2. To give effect to the above reservation, the instructions issued by the Government vide Department of Personnel letter No.Per.(AP)-C-B(12)-1/98, dated 20.8.1998 regarding maintenance of post-based reservation roster, the first Appendix to Annexure-"B" and "C" covering "Horizontal Reservation" may be deemed to have been amended to the following extent:-

## DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH SERVICES & SPORTS, HIMACHAL PRADESH

### RULES OF EMPLOYMENT CELL FOR DISTINGUISHED SPORTS-PERSONS

The following are the proposed rules of Employment Cell for distinguished sports-persons:-

1. Distinguished sports-persons falling in the categories mentioned in Annexure 'A' will be required to get their names registered with the Sports Persons Employment Cell located in the Directorate of Youth Services & Sports, Himachal Pradesh.
2. The distinguished sports-persons will have to apply to the Incharge, Sports Persons Employment Cell (Deputy Director, Youth Services & Sports) on prescribed proforma (Annexure B) for getting their names registered with the Employment Cell.
3. After receipt of application for registration, the Incharge, Employment Cell will verify whether the candidate is eligible for registration. If eligible, the name of the candidate will be entered in the Employment Cell register and registration number will be communicated to the candidate by post. This registration number will be used for all future correspondence.
4. The name of a candidate once registered on the Employment Register would remain on the register till such time, he gets proper employment.
5. The Incharge of the Employment Cell would also maintain a separate file for each registered candidate in which complete bio-data of a candidate alongwith all employment related correspondence with respect to the candidate would be maintained.
6. Various Departments/Corporations of the Himachal Pradesh Government would write to the Sports Persons Employment Cell whenever they have to make recruitment against 3% sports quota. The requisition would be made on plain paper giving the particulars of the post to be filled-up including salary and the minimum qualification etc.
7. As soon as the requisition is received, the Incharge, Employment Cell will enter the particulars of the post on a Vacancy Register. This register would be maintained in Employment Cell besides the Employment Cell Register. The vacant posts would continue to stand on the Vacancy Register till these are filled up.
8. Incharge, Employment Cell will sponsor one name per vacancy to the recruiting agency, if suitable candidate is available from categories I or II or III.

9. The following procedure shall be adopted for selecting candidates to be sponsored:-

(a) First preference will be given to candidates belonging to category I followed by category II and so on up to the last category. The preference of the international events would be in order to :-

- (i) Olympic Games.
- (ii) Winter Olympic Games.
- (iii) Commonwealth Games.
- (iv) Asian Games.
- (v) Winter Asiad.

(b) This order will be valid for category I and II. Similarly, for the national events, the order will be as follows:-

- (i) National Games.
- (ii) Recognised Senior National Level Championships.
- (iii) All India Inter-Varsity Sports Tournaments.
- (iv) All India National School Games.
- (v) Junior National Sports Championships.

(c) Within one category, first preference will be given to the Gold Medal Winner followed by Silver Medal Winner followed by Bronze Medal Winner and then participation who has merely participated but won no medals.

(d) The categorisation as well as the medals to be considered would be based on the single best achievement of the candidate. Other achievements would be considered only if there is a tie of more candidates falling in the same category and having the same level of achievements.

(e) In case the category and the level of achievement is the same for two or more categories, then the system of the points would be adopted as follows:-

10. All achievements of each candidates in various events falling in the categories to which these sports persons belong (where there is a tie) would be awarded points as mentioned above. These would then be added to give a score to each candidate. The candidate with higher score would get preference.

11. If there is still a tie, then the achievements of each candidate in the events falling in the next lower category would be given points as mentioned above and these points would be added to determine score of each candidate. Again the candidate with higher score would get preference. Again if, there is a tie, we would move to a still lower category & so on.

12. If all categories are exhausted but still there is a tie then the candidate who is more deserving on the basis of qualifications and suitability for the post would get preference. This will be decided by the Director, Youth Services & Sports.

13. Incharge Employment Cell shall on the basis of above merit/criteria, draw up a list of candidates in order to merit.

14. Before sponsoring names of the candidates against available vacancies, the Incharge, Employment Cell shall also look into :-

- (i) The qualifications indicated by the employer.
  - (ii) The job preference indicated by the candidate.
- Only candidates who meet the requirements of the job would be considered for a particular job.

15. In case more than one type of job is available then the persons higher in merit would be sponsored for the job which is higher in the list of priorities..
16. If candidate higher in merit has given his preferences but the available jobs do not fall into any of these preferences and further if the candidate has indicated that he is not to be considered for any other job, then the candidate next in merit will be considered and so on.
17. The Employment Cell shall sponsor candidates from categories I, II & III only in the first instance. In case, no candidate for the first three categories is available then a non-availability certificate would be given to the requisitioning department and the department then would be free to fill up the post from the IV category as specified in Department of Personnel letter No.2-1/72-DP(A-11) dated 28<sup>th</sup> May, 1999.
18. In case, the Department/Corporation come back to the Employment Cell & asks for sponsoring candidates out of category IV then again the sponsoring will be done on merit to be determined as indicated above.
19. In case a sponsored candidate either fails to join or is found ineligible by the employer due to medical unfitness or lack of basic qualifications, the employer shall write to Employment Cell asking for fresh names.
20. In case a sports person registered with the Employment Cell is sponsored but fails to join on his own negligence, his name can be removed from the Employment Register by the Director, Youth Services & Sports. The Director, Youth Services & Sports can enter the name of such a candidate for registration if he is satisfied that the candidate is now serious about getting employment or that he could not join due to reason beyond his control.
21. The requisitioning department and the Sports Persons Employment Cell will bear no burden or expenditure incurred by the sports persons for an interview.


