RECRUITMENT AND PROMOTION RULES FOR THE POST OF COACH IN THE DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH SERVICES AND SPORTS, HIMACHAL PRADESH.

- 1. Name of the post : Coach
- 2. Number of posts : 6 (Six)
- 3. Classification : Class-III (Non-Gazetted) Non Ministerial Services.
- 4. Scale of pay : Rs. 5800-200-7000-220-8100-275-9200
- 5. Whether Selection post or Non-Selection post : Non-Selection
- 6. Age for direct recruitment : N.A.
- 7. Minimum Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits. : N.A.
- 8. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees. : N.A.
- 9. Period of probation, if any : Two years subject to such further extension for a period not exceeding one year as may be ordered by the competent authority in special circumstances and reasons to be recorded in writing.
- 10. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion, deputation, transfer and the percentage of posts to be filled in by various methods. : 100% by promotion.
- 11. In case of recruitment by promotion, deputation, transfer, grade from which : By promotion from amongst Jr. Coaches who have completed 10 years (Regular) service or regular combined with

Note:

In all cases of promotion, the continuous adhoc service rendered in the feeder post, if any, prior to regular appointment to the post shall be taken into account towards the length of service as prescribed in these rules for promotion subject to the condition that the adhoc appointment/promotion in the feeder category had been made after following proper acceptable process of selection in accordance with the provision of R&P Rules.

Provided that: (i) in all cases where a junior person becomes eligible for consideration by virtue of his total length of service (including the service rendered on adhoc basis, followed by regular service/ appointment) in the feeder post in view of the provision referred to above, all persons senior to him in the respective category/post/ cadre shall be deemed to be eligible for consideration and placed above the junior person in the field of consideration;

Provided further that all incumbents to be considered for promotion shall possess the minimum qualifying service of atleast 3 years or that prescribed in the R&P Rules for the post, whichever is less;

Provided further that where a person becomes ineligible to be considered for promotion on account of the requirements of the preceding proviso, the person(s) junior to him shall also be deemed to be ineligible for consideration for such promotion.

EXPLANATION: The last Proviso shall not render the junior incumbents ineligible for consideration for promotion if the senior ineligible persons happened to be ex-servicemen recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of The Demobilised Armed Forces Personnel (Reservation of vacancies in Himachal State Non-Technical Services) Rules, 1972 and having been given the benefit of seniority thereunder or recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of the Ex-servicemen (Reservation of vacancies in the Himachal Pradesh Technical Services) Rules, 1985 and having been given the benefit of seniority thereunder.

(2) Similarly, in all cases of confirmation continuous adhoc service rendered in the feeder post, if any, prior to the regular appointment against such post shall be taken into account towards the length of service, if the adhoc appointment/promotion had been made after proper selection and in accordance with the provision of the R&P Rules;

Provided that inter-se-seniority as a result of confirmation after taking into account, adhoc service rendered as referred to above shall remain unchanged.

13. Circumstances under which the HPPSC is to be consulted in making recruitment. As required under the Law.
