NOTIFICATION

In supersession of all previous Notifications, the Governor of Himachal Pradesh in pursuance of powers conferred under clause (iii) of proviso to sub rule (1) of rule 108 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 and all other powers enabling her in this behalf, is pleased to specify the following dignitaries/ Senior Officers/ Persons authorized to use red/blue light to the front top of their official vehicles:-

- 1. Red light with flasher on the top front of the vehicle, while on duty anywhere in the State:-**
 - (a) Governor of Himachal Pradesh
 - (b) Chief Minister of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (c) Former Governors/Chief Ministers of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (d) Chief Justice, High Court of Himachal Pradesh
 - (e) Speaker of Himachal Pradesh Vidhan Sabha.
 - (f) Cabinet Ministers of the Himachal Pradesh.
 - (g) Leader of the Opposition in the Himachal Pradesh Vidhan Sabha.
 - (h) Judges of the High Court of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (i) Prime Minister of the Tibetan Government in exile within the State of Himachal Pradesh.
- 2. Red Light without flasher on the top front of the vehicle, while on duty anywhere in the State:-**
 - (a) Deputy Speaker of Himachal Pradesh Vidhan Sabha.
 - (b) Chief Secretary of Himachal Pradesh.
 - (c) Director General of Police, Himachal Pradesh.
 - (d) Advocate General, Himachal Pradesh.
 - (e) Chairman, Himachal Pradesh Public Service Commission.
- 3. Blue Light with flasher on the top front of the vehicle, while on duty in their respective jurisdictions.**
 - (a) Divisional Commissioners/ Inspector General of Police of respective range.
 - (b) Deputy Commissioners/Superintendents of Police of districts.
- 4. Blue Light without flasher on the top front of the vehicle, while on duty in their respective jurisdictions.**
 - a) Sub Divisional Magistrates/ Sub Divisional Police Officers.

5. Multi-colored flashing lights.

- (a) Ambulances/Fire Services/Police/Emergency/Recovery vehicles.
- (b) The vehicles escorting the high dignitaries, entitled to use Red Light shall use only Blue light, as per sub rule (3) of rule 108 of The Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989.

- 6. No Motor Vehicle except those specified in sub rule (3) of rule 119 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 can be fitted with multi-toned horns.
- 7. The Red Light shall be used only when the dignitary/officer is on duty, when he/she is on personal visit, then such red light shall be covered by black cover.
- 8. In case the vehicle fitted with red light on top front is not carrying the dignitary, then such red light shall not be used and be covered by black cover.
