Provided further that an officer for whom no departmental Examination was prescribed prior to the notification of these rules and who has not attained the age of 45 years on 1-3-76 shall not be required to qualify the departmental Examination prescribed under these rules after attaining the age of 50 years for the purpose of (i) crossing of efficiency bar next due to completion of probationary period.

Confirmation in the service after

- (2) An officer on promotion to higher post in his direct line of promotion shall not be required to pass the aforesaid examination if he has already passed the same in the lower gazetted post.
- (3) The Government may in consultation with the H.P. Public Service Commission grant an exceptional circumstances and for reasons to be reduced writing exemption in accordance with the departmental examination Rules to any class or category of persons from the departmental Examination in whole or in part provided that such officer is not likely to be considered for any other higher promotion before the date of his superannuation.
