Reservation in services for the Children / Grand-Children of Freedom Fighters---Instructions thereto regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to the instructions issued by the Govt. vide Department of Personnel letter No. Per. (AP-II) D (2)-10/83, dated the 16th October, 1984, vide which 2% reservation has been provided to the children/grand children of Freedom Fighters belonging to the State of H.P. in direct recruitment to all posts/services i.e. Class-I, II, III & IV under the State of Himachal Pradesh including all Public Sector Undertakings/Body Corporates etc. and thereafter, other relevant instructions issued on the above subject from time to time as noted in the Margin (copy of each enclosed). It has been brought to the notice of the Govt. that in the event of non-availability of wards of Freedom Fighters, the point(s) reserved for them are not being carried forward for subsequent three recruitment years as provided under the instructions issued vide this Department's letter



It is, therefore, emphasized upon all concerned that 2 % reservation provided to the wards of Freedom Fighters in direct recruitment in respect of Class-I to IV posts/services may be followed pursuant to the procedure as laid down under the instructions issued from time to time, in letter and spirit. The Government will view any departure from these instructions seriously, which may be followed strictly and also brought to the notice of all concerned for compliance.



Copy of letter No.Per. (AP-II) D (2)-10/83, dated 16-10-1984 from the Commissioner- cum- Secretary (Personnel) to H.P. Government addressed to all Secretaries/Heads of Departments/Deputy Commissioners in Himachal Pradesh etc.

Subject:- Reservation in services for the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters.

I am directed to say that the question of providing reservation in services/posts to the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters belonging to Himachal Pradesh, in case of direct recruitment under the State of Himachal Pradesh, had been engaging the attention of the Government for quite some time past. After careful consideration, it has been decided that henceforth there will be 2% reservation to the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters belonging to this State in direct recruitment to all services/posts i.e. Class-I, II, III & IV under the State of Himachal Pradesh including all Public Sector Undertakings/Body Corporates.

2. To give effect to the above reservation for the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters in the services/posts, the following Roster Points under two- sets of model rosters of direct recruitment are prescribed :-

40-Point Roster

Class-I & II

40th Point in 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th cycles, 5th cycle 'Nil' and then repetition.

Class-III & IV

100-Point Roster
38th & 90th

In case of non-availability of the eligible children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters against the posts reserved for them in any recruitment year, such posts shall automatically be treated as un-reserved and filled accordingly.

Subject: - Reservation in services for the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters.

I am directed to invite your attention to the correspondence resting with this Department letter of even number, dated 7-12-1985 on the subject cited above and to say that the Government of Himachal Pradesh (General Administration Department) have now framed and issued appropriate guidelines/orders vide their circular letters No. GAD-E (F) 4-28/85, dated, 17.12.1985 and 21.12.85 wherein the definition of Freedom Fighters has been prescribed as under:-

(i) The person who has been sanctioned or will be sanctioned freedom fighters pension under the Freedom Fighters Pension Scheme, 1972 and 1980 by the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi ;

Or

(ii) The person who is receiving or will be granted financial assistance under the Himachal Pradesh Freedom Fighters Financial Assistance Scheme, 1985.

(iii) Only the children of the son of the Freedom Fighter will be taken under the definition of grand-children of Freedom Fighter.

2. Keeping in view the above position, it is now clarified that the 2% reservation in all posts/services as provided by this Department vide letter of even number, dated 16-10-1984 shall only be applicable to the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters, who fall under the definition of Freedom fighters, as referred to above.

Subject: - Relaxation of upper age limit for Children /Grand Children of Freedom Fighters for entries into Government Service.

.....

I am directed to say that the Government have provided 2% reservation in direct recruitment to Class -I to IV posts to the Children / Grand Children of Freedom Fighter. The question of allowing age relaxation to the Children / Grand Children of Freedom Fighters as allowed to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Backward Classes and Physically handicapped persons was under consideration of the Government for some time past. It has now been decided by the Govt. that Children / Grand Children of Freedom Fighters be given 5 years relaxation in upper age limit for their entry into Government service in direct recruitments for the posts in all Departments excepting the Police Department.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to the instructions contained in this Department letter No.Per.(AP-II) D(2)-10/83, dated 16.10.1994 vide which 2% reservation has been provided by the Government to the children/grand children of Freedom Fighters belonging to the State of Himachal Pradesh in direct recruitment to all services/posts i.e. Class-I,II,III & IV under the State of Himachal Pradesh including all Public Sector Undertakings/Body Corporate. These instructions also provide that in the event of non-availability of the eligible children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters against the posts reserved for them in any recruitment year, such posts shall automatically be treated as un-reserved and filled accordingly.

The matter regarding carrying forward of the reservation in the absence of eligible wards of Freedom Fighters has been engaging attention of the Government and it has now been decided that henceforth, in case of non-availability of the eligible children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters against the posts reserved for them in any

recruitment year these posts will be carried forward for subsequent three recruitment years whereafter their reservation would automatically lapse.

I am directed to invite your attention to the instructions contained in this Department letter No.Per.(AP-II)D(2)-10/83, dated the 3rd February, 1986 vide which consequent upon issuance of appropriate guidelines/orders by the General Administration Department regarding definition of Freedom Fighters, 2% reservation in all posts/services as provided by the Personnel Department vide its letter No.Per.(AP-II)D(2)-10/83, dated 16.10.1984, has been made applicable to the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters who fall under the definition of Freedom Fighters and to say that it has been brought to the notice of the Government by the H.P. Public Service Commission that the sons/grand-sons/daughters/grand-daughters of Freedom Fighters, who have been appointed on regular basis in Government/Semi Government or Private Sectors etc. are applying for the reserved posts of wards of Freedom Fighters in response to their advertisement. Therefore, the H.P. Public Service Commission has sought for clarification as to whether such wards of Freedom Fighters who stand appointed on regular basis as well as the married daughters/grand-daughters, are entitled for the benefits of reservation or will cease to enjoy the benefits of wards of Freedom Fighters.

2. In view of above narration, the matter in-question had been engaging the attention of the Government for quite some time past. After careful consideration, it has now been decided that those sons / grand-sons / daughters / grand-daughters of Freedom Fighters who have been appointed on regular basis as well as the married daughters/grand-daughters shall not be entitled for the benefits of reservation provided to the wards of Freedom Fighters in services, against the identical posts in the same scale. The


employed children / grand-children and married daughters/grand-daughters of Freedom Fighters will be deemed to have been excluded from the definition of Freedom Fighters for the purpose to this extent.

3. Besides, it is also clarified that the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters who have been appointed in Govt./Semi Govt. or Private Sectors etc. services against the posts reserved for the wards of Freedom Fighters on regular basis will remain entitled to compete for higher rank/grade posts/services on the basis of reservation earmarked to the wards of Freedom Fighters.

4. These instructions may please be followed strictly and also brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance.

5. These instructions shall take immediate effect.



I am directed to invite your attention to the instructions contained in this Department letter No.PER(AP-II) -D(2)-10/83, dated 16.10.1984 vide which 2% reservation has been provided by the Government to the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters belonging to the State of Himachal Pradesh in direct recruitments to all services/posts i.e. Class-I,II, III & IV under the State of Himachal Pradesh including all Public Sector Undertakings/Body Corporates. Now it has come to the notice of the Government that grand-children of the Freedom Fighters are being preferred over their Sons/daughters in recruitments to services. It has, therefore, been decided by the Government that while giving reservation to the children/grand-children of Freedom Fighters, first preference may be given to their children and only in the event of non-availability of eligible/suitable children of the Freedom Fighters, their grand-children may be considered for recruitment in services in future.

I am directed to invite your attention to the instructions contained in the Department letter no. 272(2-111) dated 15.10.1981 vide which the reservation has been provided by the Government to the children/grand-children of Probation Officers belonging to the State of Himachal Pradesh in direct appointments to all service posts. It is noted that under the State of Himachal Pradesh including all Public Sector Undertaking/Body Corporations, now in the process of the Government that grand-children of the Probation Officers are being included over their own children in recruitment in services. It has, therefore, been decided by the Government that while giving reservation in the children/grand-children of Probation Officers, this preference may be given to their children and only in the event of non-availability of eligible children of the Probation Officers, their grand-children may be considered for recruitment in services in future.
