Tender document for procurement of one 40 KVA Diesel Generator set by the office Director of Land Records, HP

1. Bids shall be submitted at Directorate of Land Records, HP, Block No-28, SDA Complex , Kasumpti, Shimla-09, on or before the scheduled time and date.
2. Tenderer/Contractor/Bidders are advised to follow the instructions provided in this document
3. Bid document may be downloaded from <https://himachal.nic.in/revenue>. The bidder advised to keep visiting this website for changes that may be incorporated in the tender document subsequently.
4. The Bidder shall not be permitted to withdraw his offer or modify the terms and conditions thereof. In case the bidder fails to observe and comply with stipulation made herein or backs out after quoting the rates, the amount of earnest money deposited by such bidder shall stand forfeited.
5. **Tender Cost Fee:**
Applicant bidder shall submit the demand draft of a Nationalized/ scheduled Bank for Rs 1,000/- (Rupees One Thousand only) as **non-refundable** tender fee in favour of “Director of Land Records” with the bid. All applicable charges shall be borne by the bidder and no claim whatsoever on this account shall rest on the Department/Government.
6. **Earnest Money Deposit:**
 - a) The bidder shall be required to submit the Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for an amount of **Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only)** in the form of Bank Draft drawn in favour of **Director Land Records, HP, Payable at Shimla**. The EMD of the unsuccessful bidder shall be returned after the completion of bidding process and that of the Successful bidder after deposit of Performance Security on the award of the contract. No interest will be payable by the Department on such retention of the EMD.
 - b) The Firm who are registered with MSME/ **Or** Small Scale Industries (SSI) are exempted to submit the EMD (Copy of registration must be provided along with the technical bid).
7. The bid documents of original instruments in respect of cost of tender document, earnest money deposit etc. must be delivered to the Director Land Records, HP on or before last date/time of Bid Submission as mentioned above. **The bid without tender fee and EMD will be summarily rejected.**
8. **Submission of Bid/Tender:**
The tender shall be submitted in two part : **1. Technical bid and 2. Financial bid**. All the pages of bid being submitted must be signed and sequentially numbered by the bidder irrespective of nature of Content of the documents.

The offers submitted by Telegram/Fax/email shall not be considered. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

I. Technical Bid

The following documents are to be furnished by the bidder alongwith **Technical Bid** as per the tender document:

- a) Duly filled format of Technical Bid as per Annexure–II.
- b) Copy of constitution or legal status of the bidder: manufacturer/Sole proprietorship/firm /agency/authorized supplier/dealer etc.
- c) Financial Status: - The tenderer who have an average annual turnover of Rs. 50 Lakh for the last three completed financial years. The tenderer shall submit proof of the same.
- d) The technical bid should be accompanied by Demand draft Rs.1000/-(non-refundable) against tender fee and Demand Draft for an amount of Rs. 15,000. Demand Drafts of tender fee and EMD should be **prepared separately and drawn in favor of Director Land Records, HP Payable at Shimla.**
- e) Certificate of Manufacturer / Authorized Distributor.
- f) Experience Certificate of the Bidder/OEM.
- g) Copy of GST clearance as on 31.03.2022 from the competent authority.
- h) Copy of G.S.T registration certificate
- i) Copy of Pan Card.
- j) Authorized Service Dealer Certificate.

II. Financial Bid

- a) Price bid Form - Price must be quoted as per format specified at **annexure -III**, failing which tender shall be summarily rejected.

General Term & Conditions

1. **Validity:** The quoted rates must be valid for a period for 180 days from the date of closing of the tender. The overall offer for the assignment and bidder's quoted price shall remain unchanged during the period of validity. If the bidder quoted the validity shorter than the required period, the same will be treated as unresponsive and it may be rejected.

In case the tenderer withdraws, modifies or change his offer during the validity period, bid is liable to be rejected and the earnest money deposit shall be forfeited without assigning any reason thereof. The tenderer should also be ready to extend the validity, **if required**, without changing any terms, conditions etc. of the original tender.

2. Technical Evaluation:

(a) Detailed technical evaluation shall be carried out by Directorate of Land Records pursuant to conditions of the tender document as given at **Annexure-I**, to determine the substantial responsiveness of each tender. For this clause, the substantially responsive bid is one that conforms to all the eligibility and terms and condition of the tender without any deviation. The Directorate's

determination of bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence. The Department shall evaluate the technical bids also to determine whether they are complete, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed and whether the bids are in order.

- (b) DLR shall have right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.

3. Financial Evaluation:

- (a) The financial bid of only of those bidders who have been found to be technically eligible, shall be opened. The financial bids shall be opened in presence of representatives of technically eligible bidders, who may like to be present. Date, place and time for opening of financial bid is given in para no 4 of this document below.
- (b) Arithmetical errors shall be rectified on the following basis:- If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and total price, the **unit price shall prevail** and the total price shall be corrected by the DLR. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the **lesser amount** shall be considered as valid. If the Supplier does not accept the correction of the errors, his bid shall be rejected.
- (c) After due evaluation of the bids, the **Directorate of land Records HP** shall award the contract to the **lowest evaluated responsive tenderer**.
- (d) Conditional bid will be treated as unresponsive and will be rejected.

4. Venue, Date and Time for opening of the bids:

- (a) Technical Bids shall be opened **first on 13.03.2023 at 11.00 am** in the office of Joint Director, Directorate of Land Records, Block No.28, SDA complex, Shimla-9, HP by the tender committee constituted in this regard. Evaluation of the bid vis-a-vis the specifications and conditions mentioned herein shall be done.
- (b) Financial Bids of only of the tenderers qualified in the technical evaluation shall be opened **on 13.03.2023 at 2.30 pm** in the office of Joint Director, Directorate of Land Records, Block No.28, SDA complex, Shimla-9, HP by the tender committee constituted in this regard.
- (c) Bidder with **lowest evaluated responsive tender for DG Set** of the intended specifications as per technical bid shall qualify for the award of work. However the final decision will rest with the Director Land Records.

- 5. **Award of Contract:** The **Directorate of land Records HP** shall consider placement of orders for jobs on those bidders whose offers have been found technical and financially acceptable. The DLR reserves the right to counter offer price(s) against price(s) quoted by any bidder.

- 6. Signing of Contract:** The successful bidder shall be required to execute the Contract Agreement accepting all terms and conditions stipulated herein on a non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 100/- (Rs. Hundred only) within fifteen days of the issue of the Letter of Award of the Contract along with Performance Security. In the event of failure on the part of the successful bidder to sign the Contract within the period stipulated above, the EMD shall be forfeited and the acceptance of BID shall be considered as cancelled.
- 7. Performance Security :** The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Security Deposit of 5% of the order value in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized Bank duly pledged in the name of the “Director of land Records, HP , Payable at Shimla” after receipt of supply order. If the bidder is registered with MSME, the exemption can be given for the security Deposit.
- The Performance Security can be forfeited by order of this Directorate in the event of any breach or negligence or non-observance of any condition of contract or for unsatisfactory performance or non-observance of any condition of the contract. Performance Security will be discharged after completion of all the contractual obligations and warranty period. The Performance Security amount will not carry any interest.
- 8. Demonstration:** The bidders may be asked to demonstrate the product as and when required by the **Directorate** failing which their bids/offer shall be rejected. The firms are intimated that they should get ready for demonstration and only 15 days time will be provided for arrangement of demonstration and no request for extending time for demonstration will be entertained. In case of Failure to demonstrate, their offer will be summarily rejected. The expenditure incurred for demonstrating the items will be borne by the supplier, no Claim in this regard will be entertained.
- 9. Rate:** Prices of individual items should be inclusive of all taxes and duties including, Customs Duty, Excise Duty, GST, etc. It should also include packing, forwarding, transport, insurance, loading/unloading, installation, entry fee and toll charges etc. Rate should be quoted only in **Indian Rupees (INR)** on DOOR Delivery Basis at the site of installation of the DG Set at Directorate of Land Records, Block No.28, SDA Complex, **Shimla -9**. inclusive of all the Charges, with break-ups as:
- Basic Cost.
 - GST/Other taxes.
 - Total Cost F.O.R. at DLR Shimla-9.
- 10. Manufacture authorization Certificate:** The bid must be submitted by manufacturer or authorized distributor/dealer. The bidders are required to submit manufacturer’s authorization certificate on company’s letter head along with the technical bid (Documentary proof must submitted with technical bid).
- 11. Warranty/Guarantee:**
- (a) For the equipment the bidder must quote for minimum **02years** comprehensive on-site warranty (Including all Spares, Accessories and Labour) from the date of completion of the satisfactory installation. The warranty charges shall not be quoted separately otherwise the offer shall be

summarily rejected. Failure to comply this condition will entail the rejection of the bids.

(b) No offer of the vendor will be accepted without warranty/ guarantee of their supplied/ installed goods.

12. Uptime guarantee: The firm should provide uptime guarantee of 95% of Generator. The default during warranty period must be removed in 48 Hours or 3 Working day.

13. Down time penalty:

(a) During the comprehensive warranty period, the guarantee uptime of 95% of 365 days will be ensured. In case the down time exceeds the 5% limit penalty, of extension of guarantee period by two days for each additional day of down time will be enforced. The vendor must undertake to supply all spares for optimal upkeep of the equipment for at least **FIVE YEARS** after handing over the unit to the DLR. If accessories /other attachment of the system are procured from the third party, then the vendor must produce cost of accessory/ other attachment and the CMC from the third party separately alongwith the main offer and the third party will have to sign the CMC with the HPNLU if required.

(a) The principal or the authorized service providers are required to submit a certificate that they have satisfactory service arrangements and fully trained staff available to support the uptime guarantee.

14. Authority of person signing document: A person signing the tender form or any documents forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warranty, that he has authority to bind such other and if, on enquiry, it appears that the person so, signing had no authority to do so, the DLR without prejudice to other Civil and criminal remedies cancel contract and held the signatory liable for all cost and damages.

15. Delivery and Installation:

- a. The items shall be delivered and successful installed/ commissioned within **7 days** from the issue of supply order at the site at Directorate of Land Records HP at Block no 28, SDA Complex, Shimla-9.
- b. The successful bidder will also provide required training free of cost for supplied items at DLR HP. The goods should have been manufactured after adoption of latest technology.
- c. All the aspects of safe delivery, installation and commissioning shall be the exclusive responsibility of the supplier. If the supplier fails to deliver, install and commission the goods on or before the stipulated date, then a penalty at the rate of 0.5% per week of the total order value shall be levied subject to maximum of 10% of the total order value.
- d. If at any time during the currency of the contract, the supplier encounters conditions hindering timely supply of the goods and performance of services, the supplier shall promptly inform the **Directorate of land Records, HP** for extension of the delivery schedule accordingly. On receiving the supplier's communication, **Directorate of land Records, HP** shall examine the situation as soon as possible and, at its discretion, may agree to extend the delivery schedule, with or without liquidated damages for completion of supplier's contractual obligations by issuing an amendment to the contract.

- e. In the case of package supply where the delayed portion of supply materially hampers installation and commissioning of the systems, liquidated damages charges shall be levied as above on the total value of the concerned package of the purchase order. Quantum of liquidated damages assessed and levied by the purchaser shall be final and not challengeable by the supplier.

16. Right of acceptance: The **Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh** reserve the right to accept the whole or any part or portion of the bid; and the bidder shall provide the same at the rates quoted. **Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh** reserve the right to reject any or all tenders/quotations or all offers received in response to the tender or cancel or withdraw the tender notice without assigning any reason. Thereof and also does not bind itself to accept the lowest quotation or any tender and no claim in this regard shall be entertained.

17. Inspection:

- (a) **The Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9** shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the NIT Specifications at no extra cost to the Purchaser.
 - (b) **The Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9** right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the Goods after the goods arrival at the final destination shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the Goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by any other authority or agency.
 - (c) **The Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9** shall be the final authority to reject full or any part of the supply which is not conforming to the specification and other terms and conditions of this tender or the subsequent agreement.
 - (d) No payment shall be made for rejected supply. Rejected items must be removed by the Bidders within two weeks of the date of rejection at their own cost and replaced immediately. In case these are not removed, these will be auctioned at the risk and responsibility of the suppliers without any further notice.
- 18. Payment Term:** The Bill in triplicate may be sent to this office for settlement after satisfactory delivery & installation/ commissioning of the material. The bill should have full particulars of the items. No Payment shall be made in advance nor shall the loan from any or financial institutions be recommended on the basis of the order of award of work. The bidder shall submit the bill only after supply & installation/ commissioning of the material to the satisfaction of the **Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9**. The case of issuing sanction and passing of bill for payment will be initiated on receipt of a pre-receipted invoice from the Contractor. No payment will be made for goods rejected.
- 19. Specification:** Bids which are not meeting the bid specifications are not permitted and will be rejected.
- 20. Experience:** Bidder/OEM should have at least 5 year experience in the same industry (documentary proof must uploaded with technical bid). Bidders who do not have the requisite experience will be rejected.
- 21.** Bidder is allowed to quote for only one brand for Generator & Alternator with international presence but the bidder shall be required to quote for all items.
- 22.** Bidder should also be Authorized Service Dealer of the Brand Quoted for.
- 23. Arbitration:** If any difference arises concerning this agreement, its interpretation on payment to the made there -under , the same shall be settled out by mutual consultation and negotiation. If attempts for conciliation do not yield any result within a period of 30 days, The decision of The **Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9** will be final.

24. **Breach of Terms and Conditions:** In Case of breach of any terms and conditions as mentioned above, the Competent Authority will have the right to reject the bid at any stage without assigning any reason therefor and nothing will be payable by **Directorate of land Records HP** in that event and the EMD shall also stand forfeited.
25. **Subletting of Work:** The firm shall not assign or sublet the work/job or any part of it to any other person or party without having first obtained permission in writing of **Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9**, which will be at liberty to refuse, if thinks fit. The tender is not transferable. Only one tender shall be submitted by one Bidder.
26. **Insolvency etc:** In the event of the firm being adjudged insolvent or having receiver appointed for it by a court or any other order under the Insolvency Act made against them or in the case of a company passing any resolution or making of any order for winding up, whether voluntary or otherwise, or in the event of the firm failing to comply with any of the conditions herein specified the **Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9** shall have the power to terminate the contract without any prior notice.
27. The Bidders should furnish a copy of GST registration number and last three years GST returns .Tenders not complying with this condition will be rejected.
28. GST clearance certificate as on 31.03.2022, must be furnished with the Technical bid.
29. GST/Taxes if payable extra should be clearly mentioned otherwise no GST/Taxes charges will be paid.
30. The items will have to be supplied at **Directorate of Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Block No.28, SDA complex, Shimla-9**. No transportation/cartage charges will be provided for the same.
31. Bidder shall submit a copy of the tender document and addendum/ corrigendum thereto, if any, with each page of this document should be signed and stamped to confirm the acceptance of the entire terms & conditions as mentioned in the tender enquiry document.
32. The DLR reserves the right to accept in part or in full or reject any or more tender(s) without assigning any reasons or cancel the tendering process and reject all tender(s) at any time prior to award of contract, without incurring any liability, whatsoever to the affected bidder(s).
33. The **Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9** reserves the right to accept the whole or any part or portion of the bid; and the bidder shall provide the same at the rates quoted. **Director, Land Records Himachal Pradesh, Shimla-9** reserves the right to reject any or all tenders/ quotations or all offers received in response to the tender or cancel or withdraw the tender notice without assigning any reason thereof and also does not bind itself to accept the lowest quotation or any tender and no claim in this regard shall be entertained.
34. **Applicable Law:**

- The contract shall be governed by laws and procedures established by Govt. of Himachal Pradesh, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such commercial dealings/processing.
- Any disputes are subject to exclusive jurisdiction of competent court and forum in Shimla, India only
- The Arbitration shall be held in accordance with the provision of the Arbitration and conciliations Act, 1996 and the venue of arbitration shall be at Shimla , Himachal Pradesh . The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the both parties.
- Force Majeure: Any delay due to Force Majeure will not be attributable to the supplier.

- Supply , installation ,testing and commissioning of ready to use diesel engine alternator set in acoustic enclosure of 40 KVA with Manual control Panel comprising Kirloskar/ Mahindra/ Cummins/ Ashok Leyland/Escorts diesel engine, water cooled, coupled to Kirloskar/ Crompton/ Stamford make Alternator
- AVM pads including required length of suitable size. Copper conductor unarmored XLPE cable with cable glands and lugs for inter connection between alternator and control panel, providing tools for normal maintenance and all other accessories complete as required and as per detailed specifications.
- Operating Conditions: The engine alternator shall be capable of working at any ambient temperature between 0DegC to 50DegC with relative humidity upto 95%condition.
- The working KVA rating at site condition after accounting for de-rating shall be obtained at 0.8 power factor.
- When there is an electrical main supply failure it will be required to work continuously for a period which may even exceed 24 hour at a time.

6. The set shall be capable of taking 10% overload for a period of one hour during every 12 hours.
7. Output voltage frequency and wave form: Nominal output voltage shall be 415 Volt with + 1% manual adjustment at all conditions of the load. Frequency shall be 50 Hz + 3% Hz in output wave form.
8. Diesel engine: Engine shall be reciprocating compression ignition engine as per manufacturer standard design and conforming to IS10001-1981 & BS5514.
9. Lubrication: Lubrication shall be positive pressure type lubricating all moving parts. No moving parts shall require lubrication by hand either prior to the starting of the engine or while it is in operation. Temperature and pressure gauge shall be fitted to the lubricating system.
10. Silencer: Residential silencer with approved make/supplied by the engine manufacturer shall be provided. Silencer shall be supported on both ends and located as per engine manufacturer recommendations. Silencer shall be provided outside the canopy. The exhaust system of the generator must not be positioned so as to make any mark on the fence, containers or tower.
11. Speed and governing: The engine shall operate on 1500 RPM, and be able to meet site conditions with regard to Voltage, Speed, Frequency and regulation equipped with governor of required accuracy.
12. Operator Interface: a. Manual stop/start b. Remote start/stop c. Cyclic cranking d. Alphanumeric screen e. Alter nator trim adjustment f. Model specific calibration. Field trim adjustment
13. Measurements/Instrumentation:

17. ALTERNATOR

The alternator shall be self excited, self regulated copper wound and totally enclosed for screen protected class-H insulation, designed and constructed to withstand tropical condition. Voltage regulation shall be + 1%. With digital automatic voltage regulator. The winding shall be star connected and neutral shall be brought out to the terminal box for earth with two independent earths. The terminal of the alternator output shall be enclosed in the terminal box. The AC/ DC wiring shall be separated from each other.

18. Control Panel with changeover switch: Control panel shall be cubical type made of Minimum 16 gauge CRCA sheet dust proof, vermin proof & powder coated Control panel, comprising of all safety and indication arrangements with hinged type open able covers mounted above base frame at suitable location and supported on both sides on base frame. All the control panel wiring should be easily accessible and shall have sufficient working space for making connections of cables etc. The change over of suitable rating and the separate indication lamp for DG/EB supply are to be included.
