Item No. 5 Regarding grant of license under Rent a Cab Scheme 1989.

A proposal for the grant of license/permit **for 15 motor cabs** under Rent a Cab Scheme, 1989 has been received from o/o the RTO, Mandi in favour of Shri Sushant Saini S/o Shri Sarvanand Saini, R/o Director Black Taxi India LLP. resident of Vill-Khandla, PO-Kummi, Tehsil Balh, District-Mandi H.P. The RTO Mandi has recommended the case of applicant in view of the guidelines issued by State Govt. vide notification No. TPT-A(4)-9/2015 dated 25.08.2017.

DECISION:

The item was discussed in detail and it was decided that before allowing the operation of vehicles under Rent a Motor Cab Scheme, 1989, the matter be re-examined in view of policies of guidelines of neighbouring states. Hence, the item is deferred.

Item No. 6 Regarding Permit Condition of Auto Permit.

A proposal has been received from RTO's with the request to upload the conditions of Auto Permit on Vahan-4 (On-Line) Software.

DECISION:

The STA has decided that the amended conditions of Auto Permits will be uploaded on Vahan-4 Software except Sr. No. 15 wherein it has been decided that auto rickshaw permit will not be transferred before seven years of issuance of the permit in future, except in the case of death or permanent disability of the permit holder. This condition will only be applicable on new auto rickshaw permits granted by Department in the future. However, the final terms & conditions as approved by the STA is as under: -

1. The permit holder shall drive the vehicle himself as permit has been issued under self-employment scheme.
2. The Vehicle shall be plied within 20 KM radius of headquarter mentioned in the permit but not outside the boundary of concerned revenue sub division.
3. Permit holder is not entitled to sublet the vehicle to anyone.
4. The permit holder shall comply with provision of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989. HP Motor Vehicle Rules, 1999 and HP Motor Vehicle Taxation Act, 1972 and rules thereunder as amended from time to time as also with any other rule or directions given in larger public interest by the State Govt./Transport Deptt./STA/RTA from time to time.

5. The vehicle shall possess at all times a valid certificate of fitness as may be applicable to a passenger vehicle of this category.
6. The Driver of the vehicle shall, at all times when plying the vehicle, possess a valid Driving License as may be prescribed. Non possession of the License may render the vehicle permit to be cancelled.
7. Un-authorized person shall not be allowed to drive the vehicle while plying on the route.
8. Only the specified fares or rates notified by the concerned authority from time to time shall be charged.
9. The fare table shall be exhibited inside the vehicle at all times.
10. Parking of the vehicle at any public place except as may be authorized by a competent authority may invite penalty under section 117 of MV Act.
11. The fees and taxes payable for this permit shall be paid on or before the due dates and any violation of this condition may render this permit to be cancelled or the vehicle being impounded by the competent authority at any time.
12. The driver of the vehicle shall be prohibited from carrying mobile phone on his person or within easy reach when driving the vehicle.
13. The driver shall wear the uniform as prescribed in addition to Badge/name place on uniform on his left side of the chest.
14. The owner will ensure that all safety requirements are adhered to meticulously. In case the vehicle meets with an accident because of the fault of the driver/owner, the permit shall be liable to be cancelled.
15. The permit is non-transferrable in favour of anyone before seven years except legal heir (s) or in the event of the death or permanent disability of the permit holder.

In addition to above, it was further decided that the concerned RTO's will procure the feasibility report for the plying of Auto Rickshaw in various towns from the Deputy Commissioner concerned in view of the ban imposed by the Government in the year 2004.

Item No. 7: Request of M/s Maggu Tourist Company for grant of Contract Carriage Permits in their favour.

The representation of Shri Ved Parkash Maggu, Prop. to Maggu Tourist Co., Place of Business is New Nalagarh, Village-Abhipur, Rajpura, Nalagarh, Solan, Himachal Pradesh 174101) was placed before STA to consider his case for grant of contract carriage permits for 52 seater buses.

DECISION:

The matter was discussed in detail as per provision prescribed in the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and guidelines issued by the Government/STA time to time in this regard. However, after detailed deliberation, the authority has decided to defer the item for next meeting.

Item No. 8: Application for Accreditation of Driver Training Centre, Sarkaghat by Principal, Institute of Driving Training and Research (IDTR) Society, Sarkaghat for consideration under Rule 31B of CMVR, 1989.

The proposal received from Regional Transport Officer Mandi vide letter No. RTA (M)/IDTR/DTC/(Paplog)/Mandi/2022-9288 dated 25.08.2022 regarding issuance of licence to the IDTR Centre at Paplog, Sarkaghat in favour of Member Secretary, IDTR Paplog-cum-RM, HRTC Sarkaghat, Distt. Mandi, H.P. was placed before Authority for consideration and decision.

DECISION:

The proposal/report received from RTO Mandi along with status report of the IDTR project provided by Managing Director, HRTC vide letter No. HO: 1-1(W)/2018-19/IDTR Sarkaghat-Vol-II dated 19.04.2022 was carefully examined by the Authority and after detailed deliberation, the authority has decided to accord approval in favour of Institute of Driving Training & Research (IDTR) Society, Paplog, Sarkaghat, Distt. Mandi, H.P. subject to the condition that applicant has to complete all the remaining codal formalities as per relevant provisions of CMVR, 1989 as well as the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 in letter & spirit.

Item No. 9:- Regarding the Grant of License under Rent a Motorcycle Scheme, 1997 in favour of M/S Prince Tour and Travels, Dalhousie, Tehsil Dalhousie, Distt. Chamba, Himachal Pradesh in contravention to the provisions of the Rent a Motor Cycle Scheme, 1997 by the RTO, Chamba, H.P.

The complaint of Shri Rajat Mahajan, Advocate Mahajan House, Garam Sarak, GPO, Dalhousie and Distt. Chamba, HP-176310 regarding Grant of License in contravention to the provisions of the Rent a Motorcycle Scheme, 1997 in favor of M/S Prince Tour and Travels, Dalhousie, Tehsil Dalhousie, Distt. Chamba, HP placed before Authority along with enquiry report of RTO Kangra vide letter No. TPT-RTO (D)/Rent a Motor Cycle Scheme/Prince Tour & Travels/2022-1676 dated 18.07.2022 for consideration and decision.

DECISION:

The authority heard the Enquiry Officer (RTO Dharamshala), RTO Chamba and applicant (owner of M/S Prince Tour and Travels, Dalhousie, Tehsil Dalhousie, District Chamba) in person in the meeting. The Authority examined the complaint filed by Shri Rajat Mahajan, Advocate Mahajan House, Garam Sarak, GPO, Dalhousie and Distt. Chamba, HP-176310 and enquiry report submitted by the Enquiry Officer thoroughly in view of the terms & conditions prescribed under Rent a Motor Cycle Scheme, 1997 and as per guidelines issued by State Government and STA time to time.

After detailed discussions and deliberations, the following decisions have been taken :-

1. To encourage the scheme for the sake of tourism and general public in Dalhousie town, the authority has decided to provide relaxation to have a separate sanitary block and repair shop considering the space constraint of the town Dalhousie. Further the authority also relaxed to have an in-house space parking, attached toilet facility subject to the condition that the parking as well as toilet facility is available within 50 meters radius on rent or otherwise in favour of the applicant(s) while applying for license under Rent a Motor Cycle Scheme, 1997 in Dalhousie Town.
2. The prospective applicant(s) will comply with the provisions of ibid scheme within one months and RTO Chamba will submit detailed report by way of photography and videography of the office, parking and amenities to the Secretary, State Transport Authority, H.P. for further action for all the pending applications under the scheme.
