In this connection, there has been a recent increase in COVID-19 cases reported across the country, which may potentially impact the State of Himachal Pradesh in the near future. In light of this the Health Department has already issued medical Superintendents of Government Hospitals to maintain a high level of vigilance, closely monitor the situation, and ake all necessary preventive n easures. The Health Department is also actively monitoring cases of influenza and the common cold being repeated at various healthcare facilities.

In view of the above, the general public is advised to follow the precautionary measures listed below to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and other respiratory infections:-

Mandatory wearing of masks within hospital premises for all individuals visiting healthcare facilities.
