In light of this the Health Department has already issued medical Superintendents of Government Hospitals to maintain a high level of vigilance, closely monitor the situation, and take all necessary preventive measures. The Health Department is also actively monitoring cases of influenza and the common cold being reported at various healthcare facilities.

In view of the above, the general public is advised to follow the precautionary measures listed below to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 and other respiratory infections:-

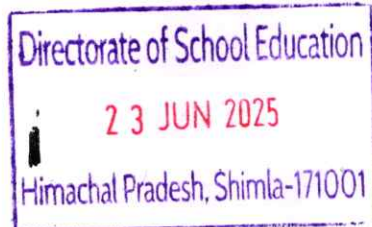
1. Mandatory wearing of masks within hospital premises for all individuals visiting healthcare facilities.
2. The use of masks is strongly recommended for senior citizens, children, and individuals with co-morbid conditions, especially when visiting crowded places.

5.
