Regarding various judgments passed by the Hon'ble High Court in light of the judgment passed in CWP No. 2171/2023 titled as Hem Raj vs. State of H.P. & ors. decided on 4th September, 2023.

Sir,

On the subject cited above it is to inform you that various petitioners, who are LTs/Shastries, have filed Civil Writ Petitions (CWPs) in the Hon'ble High Court, seeking the following reliefs:

- i) That writ of mandamus may kindly be issued, directing the respondent authorities to consider the petitioners as TGT (Sanskrit) in all respect and grant them, the pay scale of TGTs and also to consider their cadre as State Cadre from the due date in light of the judgment dated 04.09.2023 passed by this Hon'ble Court in CWP No. 2171/2023, titled as Hem Raj & others v/s State of H.P. (Annexure P-2)
- ii) That writ of mandamus may kindly be issued, directing the respondent authorities to consider the petitioners TGT (Arts) from the due date when they have acquired the essential qualification against the post of TGT (Arts) and also treat the petitioners as contractual appointees from the initial date(s) of their appointment.

The Hon'ble High Court has disposed of the these court cases with the direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in light of judgment passed in CWP No. 2171 of 2023, titled as Hem Raj vs. State of H.P & ors, decided on 4th September, 2023. Detail of court cases is as under:-

In this context, it is intimated that the matter of Sh. Hem Raj & others has been examined at Govt. level in compliance to the judgment passed by the Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 2171/2023 titled as Hem Raj vs. State of HP, CWP No. 8389/2023 to 8398 of 2023 alongwith others connected matters and Execution Petition No. 168 & 170 of 2024 and thereafter the Govt. has passed detailed speaking orders on 20.05.2024 and subsequently addendum dated 17.09.2024. Operative part of speaking order is as under:-

"Whereas, Execution Petition No. 168 & 170 of 2024 were further filed in this matter in the Hon'ble High Court & the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 19.03.2024 had directed to decide the representation within a period of six weeks.

Thus, as per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court in above mentioned CWPs & Execution Petitions, their representation dated 18-03-2023 of State President Rajkiya Bhashai Adhyapak Sangh, Himachal Pradesh has been examined and considered by the undersigned. It has been found that their main prayer is to consider the candidature of re-designated TGT (Hindi and TGT (Sanskrit) in the panel for promotion to the next higher posts i.e. Lecturer/headmaster, as the panel of eligible officials are being prepared by the Deputy Directors (Elementary Education).

It would be pertinent to mention here that the petitioners have been working as Shastri & Language Teachers in the Elementary Education Department and they were re-designated as TGT (Sanskrit) and TGT (Hindi) in their respective scales vide Notification dated 20-08-2022. Since, they have re-designated as TGTs vide the notification mentioned supra, the pay scales and promotional avenues are

admissible to them from the date of issuance of said notification i.e. 20.08.2022. The orders of Hon'ble High Court as mentioned in para 3 above also direct the same.

Thus, after considering the whole matter, I am of considered view that such re-designated TGTs(Sanskrit/Hindi) are entitled to be considered for promotion as Lecturers/Headmasters and thus they are considered for the same. However, tenure or service of such re-designated Sanskrit/Hindi Teachers as TGT shall be considered from the date of their re-designation as TGTs which in this case, is the date of notification dated 20-08-2022. It is pertinent to mention that as per the R&P Rules for the post of Lecturer (School-New) and Headmaster, there is specified period of minimum length of service as TGT(5/8 years) for a candidate to become eligible for promotion. Thus, these teachers shall become eligible for promotion only after completion of required length of service which is to be counted w.e.f. 20.08.2022, subject to the final outcome of LPA No. 86/2024 (State Vs. Hem Raj)

With these observations the representations stands disposed of and the petitioners be informed accordingly".

In view of above, you are hereby directed to consider the case of the above petitioners in light of judgment passed in CWP No. 2171/2023, titled as Hem Raj vs. State of H.P. & Ors, decided on 4th September, 2023 and examining the facts from their service records qualification (i.e. B.Ed and TET) if found similarly situated as petitioner(s) in Hem Raj's case (supra), then pass detailed speaking order after considering all aspects and extend the benefit of seniority only subject to final outcome of LPAs filed by the department in this regard.

Further, it is also directed that since the re-designated TGTs (Sanskrit/Hindi) are entitled to be considered for promotion as Lecturers/Headmasters as per notification dated 20.08.2022 and in accordance with the R&P Rules for the post of Lecturer (School-New) and Headmaster, therefore, such re-designated TGTs (Sanskrit/Hindi) be also considered only for promotional benefit to the post of Lecturers/Headmasters after completion of required length of service which is to be counted w.e.f. 20.08.2022 i.e. from the date of issuance of the notification or from the date of passing of TET/B.Ed. examination which is later, subject to the final outcome of LPAs filed by the department.

It may please be treated as **MOST URGENT**.
