OFFICE ORDER

Whereas M/S Orison Pharma International, Khari Kala Amb District Sirmour was L1 Bidder for the supply of Tab. Ranitidine 150mg and Tab. Telmisartan 40mg respectively in the tender finalized by the Govt. / Department on 31-12-2018 for a period of one year.

Whereas, as per the test report received from the Government Analyst, CTL Kandaghat, District Solan, HP that the two batches of Tab. Ranitidine 150mg batch No. 18 H-T1101, 18 G-T926 and one batch of Tab. Telmisartan 40mg Batch No. 19 C-T357, manufactured by M/S Orison Pharma International, Khari Kala Amb District Sirmour were found not of standard quality Drugs as defined in the Drugs and Cosmetic Act, 1940 and rules there under, due to the reason that the sample tablets found moistened when opened from the blistered strips for Tab. Ranitidine 150mg and for Tab. Telmisartan 40mg found broken into piece / powder when opened from blistered strips with the strength not found complies as per the test report issued vide No. CTL-Drugs/2016-8855, 8834 and 8837 dated 11-11-2019 by the Government Analyst, Kandaghat, District Solan, HP.

Whereas, relevant provisions of the tender conditions No. 19 (i), (iii), (v) (vi) and (ix) are reproduced as under: -

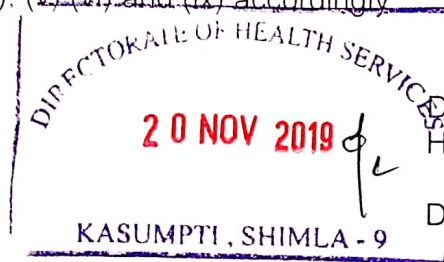
- i. The purchaser or its representative shall have the right to inspect and / or take random and representative sample for the purpose of test and analysis to ensure their conformity to the contract technical specifications / pharmacopeia standard as prescribed. The inspection and sampling shall be conducted at the goods final destination. Samples such drawn can be sent to any of the NABL accredited / govt. approved laboratory by the purchaser, the report thereof shall be accepted by the bidder.
- iii. Should an inspected or tested goods fail to conform to the specifications, the purchaser may reject them and the supplier will remove the rejected store at their cost.
- v. The debarment action will be taken against the manufacturing unit and contract holding firms (both) will be taken accordingly to the category-A and category -B defects as per guidelines issued by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Annexure-P5).
- vi. In the event of failure of their products, in addition to debarment action, the performance security of the supplier will be forfeited and testing charges involved will be recovered by Director Health and Family Welfare HP / indenting officer from the supplying firm besides the recovery of cost of product declare substandard from the balance payment of the supplier pertaining to earlier / current/ subsequent years, even if payment for that particular drugs stands already released.

- ix. The supplier will be responsible to take back the rejected items from the district store / consignee place and replaced with fresh stock duly inspected within 45 days or stipulated in the notice issued to the supplier, at their own cost up-to the consignee or district store

Whereas, after examining the terms and conditions in this respect the concerned firms are hereby debarred for supply of these medicines declared not of standard quality for a period of three years.

The indenting officers are hereby directed not to issue supply orders to the above mentioned firms for these medicines and stock lying at various district store / consignee place and at the field / distribution may not be made available for further distribution with immediate effect

All the indenting officers are also directed to initiate action as per the terms and conditions No. No. 19 (i), (iii), (v) (vi) and (ix) accordingly.
