Mobility of Personnel between Central Government Department and Autonomous Bodies-Counting of Service for rension.

The undersigned is directed to say that vide

para-7 of the instructions issued vide the Department of Personnel Administrative Reforms 0.M.No.28/10/84-Pension Hilt, dated 29th August, 1984 on the above subject these instructions are effective from the date of issue i.e. 29th August, 1984. It is further stipulated there in that the revised policy as enunciated thereunder would be applicable to those employees who retired from Government /Autonomous Body service on or after the issue of these orders.

- It has been held by the Supreme Court of India in its judgement 1 ted 12th August, 1987 in Writ Petition No.3739 of 1985-Case of Sh.R.L. Marwaha v/sUnion of India & Others that paragraph 7 of the Government order cannot be used against persons in the position of the petitioner to deny them the benefit of the post service for purpose of computing the pension.
- Supreme Court Julgement has been under consideration of the Government. The President has now been decide that the benefit under the instructions contained in the orders dated 29-8-1984. should also be extended to all those who had retired prior to the benefit of counting of service thereunder.
- to the concerned pensioners, would be disbursed to them w.e.f. 29-8-84 i.e. the late of the Government order only and that they would not be entitled to get any relief in respect of the period prior to 29-8-1984.
- Bolies may review the cases of such pensioners on recalipt of
