NOTIFICATION

In continuation and partial modification of this Department Notification No. LLR-E(9)-1/2018 dated 7th March, 2018, regarding engagement of Senior Advocates, Advocates-on-Record and Panel Advocates, to represent the State of Himachal Pradesh before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil/Criminal cases, for the existing provisions of Paras 3 and 4 the following Paras shall be substituted, namely:-

- “ 3. The terms and conditions of fee of the Senior Advocates will be notified separately after due deliberation and in consultation with the concerned Advocates and shall be communicated to all the departments accordingly. So far as the terms and conditions pertaining to Advocates-on-Record and Panel Advocates is concerned the same shall continue to be governed as per Notifications bearing No.LLR-E(9)1/88-III(Loose) dated 28th May, 2012 and 31st July, 2012.
4. The Senior Advocate, Advocate-on-Record and Panel Advocate, as the case may be, engaged by different Departments, prior to issuance of notification dated 7th March, 2018, shall be requested by the concerned Administrative Departments in consultation with District Attorney, (Legal Cell) Himachal Bhawan, 27, Sikandra Road, New Delhi for handing over the cases assigned to them alongwith the requisite “NOC” so as to assign such cases to the newly engaged Advocate(s). However, while doing so the Administrative Department shall also ensure that the fee etc. which is due to the earlier engaged Advocate(s) is paid to them as per settled terms and conditions thereof.
5. All the Departments are requested that whenever they require the services of any Advocate in the particular Civil/Criminal case or in cases of vital importance to the State, they may engage the Advocate, from the Panel notified vide notification of even number dated 07-03-2018 with the prior approval of the Law Department and in consultation with the Advocate General, Himachal Pradesh”.


