b) A Police officer intercepts a truckload of timber. What all actions are required to be taken by him under various provisions of law? (10 Marks)

Q.No.3 a) A Sub- Divisional Magistrate discovers that a spare part shop has kept huge Stocks of petrol and diesel unauthorizedly. What action he is expected to take And under which provisions of law? (10 Marks)

b) During a routine inspection, it came to the notice of a Sub- Divisional Magistrate that a pack of 10 Kg wheat flour being sold in the market and Manufactured by a flour mill operating locally from the same Sub- Division, Actually contained only 8.5 Kg. of flour.
