- Q.5 Define 'Arrest'. Under what circumstances a police officer can arrest a person without a warrant? What kind of force he can use in order to arrest a person?
- Q,6 What is an 'Unlawful Assembly'? Discuss the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure dealing with Unlawful Assembly. (20 marks)

- Q.7 Distinguish between primary evidence and secondary evidence. In what cases the secondary evidence relating to a document may be given? (20 marks)
- Q.8 What do you understand by confession? Whether confession before a police officer leading to recovery of weapon of offence is admissible in a criminal trial?
