(b) Define forgery? What is the punishment provided for using as genuine a document which is known to be forged? (10 marks)
- Q.3 (a) Explain the essential elements of wrongful confinement and distinguish it from wrongful restraint. (10 marks)  
(b) Explain the ingredients of offence of kidnapping and distinguish it from the offence of abduction. (10 marks).

- Q.4 Define First Information Report? What is the evidentiary value of the First Information Report? (20 marks)
- Q.5 What is charge? What are the contents of a valid charge? What is the effect of error in charge? (20 marks)
- Q.6 What is complaint? Discuss the procedure required to be followed by a Magistrate when dealing with the complaints. (20 marks)

- Q.7 Discuss the importance of oral and documentary evidence under the Indian Evidence Act. Discuss their respective evidentiary value. (20 marks)
- Q.8 What do you understand by confession? How much of confession before a police officer is admissible in a criminal trial? (20 marks)
- Q.9 (a) What do you mean by Burden of Proof? On whom the burden of proof as to particular fact lies. (10 marks)  
(b) What do you mean by judicial notice? What are the facts of which the court must take judicial notice? (10 marks)
