- Q.1 You are working in Directorate of Medical Education, H.P. Government as an Officer. You have been asked to prepare a Proposal/Note to be sent to the State Govt. regarding establishment of a new Medical College in Chamba District in a Public-Private-Partnership mode.

Following information may be used to prepare a reasoned Proposal/Note for consideration of the government:-

- (a) Chamba District Hospital/Other adjoining health Institutions would be attached to the private Medical College.
- (b) Locally available Government Land of Animal Husbandry Department would be offered by state government to the Private bidder on lease basis to establish the Medical College.
- (c) The Private Party willing to establish the College would be selected through a competitive bidding process on a 2 (two) bid bidding process.
- (d) Potential bidders/bids must be technically responsive on various parameters including having prior experience of running a medical college, to have financial networth of at least Rs.50.00 crores, proposed investment to be made by the potential bidder and other such relevant criteria.
- (e) Financial bids of only technically responsive bids would be opened.
- (f) A Committee to assess the bids with suitable representatives may be proposed.
- (g) Mention approvals required to be taken to establish the college as those of Medical Council of India and other regulatory authorities.
- (h) What would be the financial model of the Project i.e. whether the potential bidders would be required to give a revenue stream to the state government in lieu of complete autonomy to run the college and to determine the fees or whether the model would involve charging state government a certain amount for running the college in view of various parameters/constraints/restrictions imposed by the state government.

(i) Other assumption as may be necessary, may be made to prepare a reasoned proposal.

All assumptions/facts have not been given in the question. You are free to assume other criteria/operational details which are necessary to fill gaps in the information to enable you to prepare the proposal/note to be sent to the government.

Q.No.2. Rural Development Department intends to award outstanding work done by Non-Governmental Organisations, individuals, Local Bodies etc. in the field of Solid Waste Management, Sewerage Ttreatment and Disposal, Upkeep of Public Toilets, Propagation of new Technology in Waste Management, Construction of Household and Public Toilets etc.

Please prepare a public advertisement inviting proposals from such Persons/Organisations/Local bodies with respect to the work done by them in above mentioned fields. The advertisement should mention the various parameters on which the proposals would be evaluated by the department viz; outstanding achievement, contribution of Individuals/Organisations, benefits to the society and local community, source of funding, public contribution and participation, innovative practices etc.

Mention other relevant important information which is necessary in such a public advertisement such as prizes/awards on offer, documentary proof in support of claim, last date, supporting documents required, Visual proof etc. Make other necessary assumption so that the draft advertisement is complete in all respects and it gives complete information to potential applicants for the Award Scheme.

Q.No.3. Education department intends to start computer classes in all Senior Secondary Schools of the State. The government has earmarked a budget of Rs.20 Crores for this purpose which could be increased further in case of need for more funds.

This Project/Programme would be implemented with the help of Private Companies/Firms which provide a complete solution viz; hardware, training providers/teachers, training modules, learning material and Certified Evaluation Programmes. Students would however be charged a nominal fees as their co-contribution to meet the cost of the Computer Classes to encourage their participation.

You are requested to prepare a Draft Cabinet Memorandum for approval of the project by the Council of Ministers. The Memorandum may, among other details/facts, mention the following:-

- (a) Schools/Districts to be covered.
- (b) Financial criteria/Turnover/Experience criteria to be met by the potential bidders.
- (c) Estimated cost of the project and co-contribution of the students.
- (d) Other such models of Computer Training in School/other such best practices in other states in their schools.
- (e) Monitoring and Implementation Structure to oversee the project.
- (f) Possible positive advantages of the project.
- (g) Sources of funding.

Other relevant information as may be necessary to be included in the Draft Cabinet Memorandum, such as name of the project, facilities to be provided by the department/schools etc. may be presumed by the examinee so that the Draft Memorandum is complete in all respects. You may make necessary assumption if necessary.
