DETAIL OF VARIOUS SCHOLARSHIP/ INCENTIVE SCHEMES IN R/O OF ELEMENTARY EDUCATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE YEAR 2015-16 .

CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEMES

1. Pre-Matric (Unclean Occupation):

This scheme is 100 percent centrally sponsored scheme and the budget under this scheme is allotted by the Government of India and commuted liability by the State Government to the beneficiaries. Under this scheme (@ Rs. 1850/- i.e. Rs. 110/- per month for 10 months as scholarship for day scholars and Rs. 750/- as Adhoc grant from classes (1st to 10th) is yet to be paid to each beneficiary as sanction of amount is received from Government of India to 2124 beneficiaries and budget was received Rs. 39.30 lakh which is to be distributed soon amongst the beneficiaries through DBT/ NEFT.

2. Minority Community:

This scheme is a centrally sponsored scheme and budget is allotted by the Government of India to the students/ beneficiaries whose parents income does not exceed more than Rs.1,00,000/- per annum. This pattern from the year 2014-15 onward, has been declared as 100% Centrally Sponsored Scheme respectively. The scholarship is admissible for 10 academic months @ Rs.100/- per month as maintenance allowance from classes (1st to 10th) along with admission fee from class V1 to X @ 500/- p.a. maximum in private schools or subject to actual and tuition fee from class V1 to X @ 350/- p.m. or subject to actual. For Hostellers from classes 1 to V, no maintenance allowance/Tuition fee and Admission fee is paid. Only the maintenance allowance is paid @ Rs. 600/- per month for 10 months only i.e. Rs. 6000/- per annum. In this scheme for the year 2015-16 total beneficiaries are 3300 and budget is Rs. 65.00 lakh which is to be distributed by the Ministry of Minority Affairs through National Scholarship Portal (NSP) in the beneficiary's bank account directly.

3. Disability Scholarship Scheme:

This scheme is a centrally sponsored scheme and amount is allotted directly to the beneficiaries in their Bank Account through National Scholarship Portal and this scheme is being implemented by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment Government of India for regular full time students with more than 40 % disabilities students in classes 9th and 10th in Government Schools or schools recognized by Center/ State Board of Secondary Education Scholarship will be paid to the students whose parents/ guardians income from all sources does not exceed more than Rs. 2,00,000/- per annum. Rate of scholarship to Day scholars @ Rs. 350/- and @ Rs. 600/- for hostllers, for books as adhoc grant per annum for day scholars Rs. 750/- and for hostllers Rs. 1000/-. Monthly allowance for Blind students is Rs. 160/-, monthly transport allowance is Rs. 160/-, Escort allowance for severely Disabled i.e. with 80% or higher disability Day scholar/ students with low extremity disability Rs. 160/-, monthly helper allowances admissible to any employee of the hostel willing to extend help to a severely orthopedically handicapped student residing in the hostel of an Educational Institution who may need the assistance of a helper is Rs. 160/- and monthly coaching allowance to Mentally Retarded and Mentally ill students Rs. 240/-. For the year 2015-16, 45 beneficiaries has applied online forms in National Scholarship Portal.

STATE SPONSORED SCHEMES.

1. Girls Attendance Scholarship:

Under this scheme scholarship is paid to the girls student @ Rs 2/- per month for 10 months whose attendance is more than 90%. The budget was distributed in the year 2015-16 is Rs.6,90,500/- to 34525 beneficiaries were covered under this scheme.

2. BPL/ IRDP:

Under this scholarship scheme, an amount of Rs. 150/- per annum is paid to per beneficiary form classes 1st to 5th. During 2015-16, total budget is distributed Rs. 87,96,750/- and total 58,645 beneficiaries were covered and from class 6th to 8th an amount of Rs. 250/- per annum is paid to boys and Rs. 500/- per annum is paid to girls. During 2015-16, an amount of Rs. 2,22,00,250/- is distributed to 58542 beneficiaries are covered under this scheme.

3. Army/Border Area:

The rate of scholarship under this scheme is Rs. 150/- per annum to the students studying in classes 1st to 5th of Govt. Schools. During the year 2015-16 an amount of Rs. 300/- is distributed in 2 beneficiaries.

4. Medhavi Chhatrvariti Yojna:

Under Medhavi Chhatrvariti Yojna, an amount of Rs. 800/- p. a. per beneficiary is paid for both boys and girls. During the year 2015-16 an amount of Rs. 10.66 lakh is distributed to 1333 beneficiaries on the basis of 5th class examination.

5. Pre-Matric SC Students :

Pre-Matric Scholarship for the SC students of Govt. Schools (Both Boys and Girls) studying in classes 1st to 5th is paid @ Rs. 150/- per student per annum. No budget have been received from the Government under this scheme since last five years.

6. Lahaul Spiti Pattern:

This scheme is being implemented by the Tribal Department and the budget is also distributed by them @ Rs. 8/- per student for 10 months i.e. Rs. 80/- in tribal areas.
