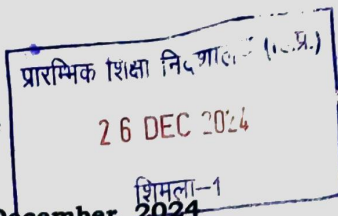

Allocation of foodgrains (rice) under Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM Poshan) Scheme i.e. for the 4th Quarter (01-01-2025 to 31-03-2025), for Bal Vatika/Pre Primary 3125.20 quintals, Primary 9504.80 quintals & Upper Primary 12122.50 quintals for the year 2024-25.

Sir,

The Government of India, Ministry of Education, Department of School Education & Literacy, Shastri Bhawan New Delhi-110115, vide letter No. 5-1 / 2024-PMP-5 dated 04.10.2024 has issued allocation of foodgrains (rice) for Bal Vatika / Pre Primary classes, Primary Stage (classes I-V) and Upper Primary Stage (classes VI -VIII) for the **4th Quarter (01-01-2025 to 31-03-2025)**, for financial year 2024-25. Accordingly, **3125.20 quintals foodgrains (rice) for Bal Vatika/ Pre Primary stage, 9504.80 quintals for Primary stage and 12122.50 quintals for Upper Primary stage** are being allocated (District wise) on the basis of average beneficiaries of 2nd quarter of the year 2024-25 as per Annexure-1. While lifting the food grains (rice), it may be ensured that the best quality foodgrains (rice), which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality FAQ, is lifted from the PDS Depot. The process followed at the time of receipt of foodgrains (rice) from FCI Depots may also be repeated at each level till the foodgrains (rice) reach the end user to ensure that only good quality foodgrains (rice) is delivered for consumption by students. However, all relevant records /samples regarding quality assurance should be maintained at all levels.

In view of the above, you are therefore requested to distribute foodgrains (rice) to the Blocks as per prescribed norms i.e. 100 gms. per child per day in respect of Bal Vatika/ Pre Primary classes & Primary classes and 150 gms. per child per day for Upper Primary classes. In this context, it is further added that the balance of foodgrains (rice) from previous month/quarter/ year may be kept in view while allocating foodgrains (rice) to the Blocks for providing Mid Day Meal to the students under Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM Poshan) Scheme. Before making further allocation of foodgrains (rice) to the Blocks following things may also be kept in view at school level and monitor the same on priority on time to time.

- **Enrollment / Beneficiary of Block / Institution**
- **Number of School Days.**
- **Approved norms is 100 gms. for Bal Vatika/ Pre Primary classes & Primary classes and 150 gms. for Upper Primary classes per child per day.**
- **Unutilized foodgrains (rice) lying with the School/ Block.**
- **(Enrollment/ Beneficiary of Block/ School * No. of Schools Days in the Quarter/ Month * approved food norms) - Unutilized foodgrains (rice) lying with the Block/ Schools= Quantity of foodgrains (rice) to be allocated to the Block).**
- **The consumption of foodgrains (rice) as well as utilization of Material cost funds may be ensured strictly as per prescribed norms for Bal Vatika/ Pre Primary & Primary and Upper Primary classes on actual number of beneficiary students on day to day basis.**

- To ensure timely supply of foodgrains (rice), allocation of rice to Blocks/ Schools should be made on Quarterly basis instead of monthly basis.
- At school level, appropriate record should be maintained and proper receipt should be obtained from the FPS/ PDS holder, indicating the quantity of foodgrains received in respect of their schools and make entries in the MDM registers accordingly.
- The information in respect of allocation, lifting, utilization and balance of foodgrains (rice) may be furnished immediately after the closure of the Quarter i.e 31-03-2025, so that further necessary action in this regard could be taken accordingly.

9. **All Block Elementary Education Officers in HP with the direction that Foodgrains (rice) allocated by the Districts may be distributed further to the schools and copy of the same be provided to all CHT/ schools, so that school should lift the allocated quantity of Foodgrains (rice) from PDS Depot. The Block should maintain monthly record of the schools in this regard, so as to facilitate the demand of Foodgrains (rice) to DDEE's for the next month. The month wise Lifting and Utilization Certificate in respect of the Foodgrains (rice) may be obtained from the schools as per specimen certificate attached at (Annexure-II)**
