

# Guidelines for the Functioning of Institutions of Excellence.

## 1. Smart Uniform for Students

- **Green House:** Prioritizing values such as growth, harmony, and sustainability, students in this house are seen wearing green to display their membership.
- **Yellow House:** Celebrating characteristics like optimism, enthusiasm, and creativity, students in this house wear yellow to express their house identity.
- **Purple House:** Representing qualities like wisdom, dignity, and ambition, students in this house wear purple clothing or accessories.
- **Orange House:** Highlighting qualities such as adventure, energy, and vibrancy, students in this house wear orange to indicate their house.
- **Pink House:** Focusing on compassion, kindness, and harmony, students in this house wear pink to express their house pride.

## 3. Activities performance on Saturdays'

- **Academic Instruction:** Teachers will engage students in interactive lessons covering core subjects like mathematics, language arts and environment science. Hands-on activities and group discussions will be incorporated to make learning engaging and enjoyable.

The morning routine begins with a moment of prayer, promoting unity and reflection. Afterward, students recite the pledge, affirming values like responsibility and patriotism. Together, these activities create a structured start to the day, nurturing holistic development and instilling important values in students

#### 5. **Remedial Classes**

The remedial classes will offer personalized support to students who require extra help in their studies, ensuring that every student will be able to keep up with their academic progress.

#### 6. **Dress-code for teachers**

A dress code for teachers is crucial for several reasons. It promotes professionalism by setting a standard for educators to maintain a sense of respect and credibility. - **Puzzle-solving exercises:** Providing age-appropriate puzzles and riddles challenges children's cognitive abilities and promotes creative problem-solving. These activities can be integrated into the curriculum to make learning engaging and enjoyable.

29. There will be baseline, midline and endline student assessments
30. School of excellence will prepare and implement School Development Plan and act as aspirational school for the area
31. School of excellence will provide mentorship support to other schools in the area
32. Attendance teacher and students will be done through electronic means
