Instructions/ guidelines regarding State Level under- 14(B&G) Tournaments for the Session 2023-24.

Memo:

As per decision on the meeting of the General Council of HESSA was held on April 18, 2023, at the Conference hall of the Directorate of Elementary Education. Shimla-1. The schedule for the organization of state-level tournaments for different games, athletic meets, and cultural programs for girls and boys (under age 14 years, born on or after 1-1-2010) of Govt. Sr. Sec. Schools, Govt. High Schools, and Govt. Middle Schools of the State for the year 2023–24 was decided as follows:

Submission of Documents

Game incharge/Chief-DE-Mission of all the districts must deposit the following documents in the State office person in the control room of State Tournament.

- i) Entry Form=2 set
- ii) The district flag of 6x4 feet size = 1

- iii) List of private school participating players in the State tournaments.
- iv) Complete list of official deputed by the DDEE and mention there assignment.
- v) Lineup Performa of all game dully attested by the game Incharge/DDEE.
 - 1. Entry of Teams: You are requested to send the information regarding the participation of your team one week prior to the start of the tournament to the organizing secretary.
 - 2. Girls Team: Mandatorily, the girls team from each district should be accompanied by at least one lady teacher as in-charge who will take care of the girls and will have to stay with the girls during the tournament, and she will be fully qualified for the same. Will be responsible for the girls troop during their stay.
 - 3. All Escort Teachers/In-Charge: 1. Will be on the school premises or venue for the safety of the sportspersons in their district. Any laxity in the matter will be viewed seriously, and action will be taken against the indiscipline teachers. 2. All Team In-Charge, DPE, PET, and OSD will attend the opening and closing ceremonies. The OSD during the matches will be in proper sports uniform while conducting the program. 3. Minor games will be played in a league-cum-knockout system.
 - **4.** Reporting Date: The tour district contingent is expected to reach the venue a day before the start of the competition
 - 5. <u>Identity Card:</u> All players must have an identity card duly signed or attested by the Head of the Institution. Without an identity card, players will not be allowed to participate in the tournament..
- 6. AADHAAR CARD:- As per guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. India, and SGFI, online linkage of AADHAAR for each participant of the National School Games at the time of online entries is now mandatory. From session 2023–24 onwards, please ensure to accept the eligibility form as mentioned along with DOB and AADHAAR documents. The DOBs of the participants on the AADHAAR and school certificates should be the same.
- 7. <u>Birth Certificate</u>: A separate photocopy of the birth certificate of each and every player of the team, duly attested by the Gazetted Officer, is required. Only the birth certificate issued by the Statistic Department of the State, UT, Central Govt., Municipal, or Corporation Form-5 or 9 Panchayat shall be acceptable for the National School Games as per SGFI direction. Sports merit and participation certificates will be verified at the venue of state-level tournaments. All the ADPEOs are directed to get the certificates verified at the venue itself.
- 8. Eligibility/ Age Certificate: All players should have official entry and eligibility forms in format (SGFI 20 Col.) in full size, duly signed or attested by the head of the institution, and countersigned by the competent authority of the district. The ADPEO and team manager will be responsible for bringing the eligibility and birth certificates of the participants, which are to be handed over to the organizing secretary. In the absence of the above formalities and documents, teams or players will not be allowed to participate in the tournament.
- 9. NOC/Risk Certificate:- It has been decided in the General Council meeting of HESSA that henceforth the Head of the Institute shall mandatorily obtain an NOC from the parents

- or guardians of the players regarding the risk involved while participating in the tournament..
- 10. Accommodation: Arrangements for the stay of all the teams shall be made at the school or hostel premises.
- 11. Arrangements:- Players and officials will have to bring with them suitable bedding and other personal daily-use items.
- 12. Arrangement of mess: -There will be a common mess. The mess menu will be prepared by the mess committee. The seating arrangements should be made in such a way that each player can comfortably eat his meal. The Principal, i.e., the organizing secretary of the state-level tournament, is instructed to constitute purchase committees well in advance of running the mess. All purchases, etc., are to be made strictly as per the norms in vogue, and all formalities are required to be complied with. Rs.120/- per day per player is admissible.
- **13.** The whole expenditure on TA/DA for the numbers of players district wise shown above in different tournaments will be borne by the HESSA.
- 14. For cultural program and yoga competitions, instructions are given that any kind of written material, posters, banners, etc. on which the name of the concerned district is printed should not be used. The same should be kept in mind regarding the attire that the yoga participants will use during the competition. The name of the district should not be mentioned so that the judges can give his decision in a transparent manner. Consider this order necessary.

The Deputy Director of Elementary Education in Una, Hamirpur, Sirmour, Solan, Shimla, and Bilaspur, where the state tournaments are being organized, will act as organizing secretary for the successful organization. They will be responsible for making all necessary arrangements for proper accommodation for the boys and girls players and officials during the tournaments. They will make suitable provision for running the common mess a Rs.120/- and the private school boys and girls @ 120/- per day per player. They will hold the meeting of the members of the executive committee of DSSA (Elementary) concerned and will form different committees well in time for the smooth and successful conduct of the tournament. The Deputy Director Cum- organizing secretary will approach and seek the cooperation and help of the Deputy Commissioner, Superintendent of Police, Chief Medical Officer, and Sub Divisional Magistrate of the concerned district for organizing the tournament in a befitting manner. Organizing secretary will direct the ADPEO of the concerned district to prepare the playing field. The senior PET's of the districts will perform the duties of the general manager of the district contingent and will be responsible for proper care of and maintaining the discipline of the players and officials during the state tournament. The team in charge and coaches are fully responsible for looking after the players.

VIPS Chief guest for the opening/closing ceremony will be finalized by the Dy. Director Cum Organizing Secretary with the prior permission of Director of Elementary Education H.P. All the officials deputed with the District contingent/OSD will attend the meeting daily and will mark their attendance in state office at their venue. Game Incharge will be fully responsible for proper look after and maintaining discipline of the players and

officials during the state Tournaments. All the Game Incharge will provide sufficient time to have rehearsals of March Past for opening & closing ceremony. Full contingent will take part in March Past. In case of any instance of indiscipline the official will be relieved forthwith by informing the Director of Elementary Education for further n/a. Game incharge of the District are directed to submit a list of PET's games and tournament wise for the State duty at the earliest. It is compulsory to participate in the cultural activities for all Districts. ADPEO (HQ) is hereby authorized to depute the officials and Players for the smooth conduct of State tournaments/coaching camp and National level tournaments. The organizing Secretary is hereby directed to depute 4 PETs in each game to help the OSD.

All tournaments running in state will be organized as per the rules

and regulations of SGFI.
