Allocation of food grains (Rice) for the 1st Quarter (01-04-2018 to 30-06-2018) under National Programme of Mid Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for Primary and Upper Primary Schools (Primary 19563.50 quintals & Upper Primary 21917.10 quintals) for the year 2018-19.

Sir/Madam,

The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Elementary Education & Literacy, Shastri Bhawan New Delhi-110001, vide their letter No. 5 -1 / 2018 – Desk (MDM) of dated 23 .03.2018 has conveyed the allocation of foodgrains (rice) for Primary Stage (classes I - V) and Upper Primary Stage (classes VI - VIII) for the 1st Quarter (01-04-2018 to 30-06-2018) for the financial year 2018-19. In this regard, it is stated that 19563.50 quintals of foodgrains (Rice) for Primary stage and 21917.10 quintals of foodgrains (Rice) for Upper Primary stage is being allocated to the districts on the basis of average beneficiary students w.e.f 01.04.2017 to 31.12.17 as per attached ANNEXURE-1. While lifting the foodgrains (rice), it may be ensured that the best quality foodgrains (rice), which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality FAQ, is lifted form the PDS Depots. The process followed at the time of receipt of foodgrains (Rice) from FCI Depots may be repeated at each level till the foodgrains (Rice) reach the end user to ensure that only good quality foodgrains (Rice) is delivered for consumption by children. Records /samples regarding quality assurance should be maintained at all levels.

In view of the above, it is requested that distribution of foodgrains (Rice) to the Blocks be made as per norms i.e. 100 gms. per child per day in respect of Primary classes and 150 gms. per child per day for Upper Primary classes. In addition to this, it is further stated that from the year 2017-18, Mid Day Meal Scheme is being introduced in the cantonment Board schools of Chamba, Kangra, Shimla and Solan District and thus foodgrains (Rice) is also distributed to the Cantonment Board schools. In this context, it may be ensured that the balance of foodgrains (Rice) from the previous quarter/ year be kept in view while allocating foodgrains (Rice) to the Blocks for providing Mid Day Meal under MDM Scheme and before making the allocation following points may be considered:-

- Enrollment / Beneficiary of Block / institution
- Number of school days
- Approved norms 100 gms. Primary classes and 150 gms. for Upper Primary classes per child per day.
- Unutilized foodgrains (Rice) lying with the school/ Block.
- (Enrollment/ Beneficiary of Block/ School * No. of Schools Days in the Quarter/ Month * approved food norms) - Unutilized foodgrains (Rice) lying with the Block/ Schools= Quantity of rice to be allocated to the Block)
- To ensure the timely supply of foodgrains (Rice), allocation of rice to Blocks/ Schools may be made on Quarterly basis instead of monthly basis.
- At school level, appropriate record should be maintained and proper receipt may be obtained from the FPS/ PDS holder, indicating the quantity of foodgrains (Rice) received in respect of their schools and make entries in the MDM registers accordingly at School level.



 The information in respect of allocation, lifting, utilization and balance of foodgrains (Rice) be furnished immediately after the closure of the first Quarter i.e. after 30-06-2018, so that further necessary action in this regard could be taken accordingly.
