Submission of Documents

Game Incharge/Chief Contingent Incharges of all the districts must deposit the following documents in the State office person in the control room of State Tournament

- i) Entry form = 2
- ii) The District Flag of 6 fitX4fit size = 1
- iii) Complete list of officials deputed by the DDEE and mention there assignment.
- iv) List of the Private schools participating players in the State tournaments.
- v) Line up performa of all games dully attested by the Game Incharge/DDEE

1. **Entry of team:-** You are requested to send the information regarding initially entry of your participation before five days of starting the tournament positively to the organizing secretary.
2. **Reporting date:-** The contingent of your district is expected to reach on day before commencement of the competition.
3. **Identity Card:-** All players must have I-card dully signed /attested by the head of the institution. Without I-card players will not be allowed to participate in tournament.
4. **Accommodation arrangement:-** Accommodation arrangement for all the team /distt. Shall be made at school. The players must bring with them light bedding and other articles of personal use.

5. **Mess arrangement:-** There will be common mess. Mess menu will be prepared by the mess committee.
6. **Photograph and signature of players:-** Passport size photograph collected from the players should have the players name, date on which the photograph was taken and signature of the players should be scanned on the photograph.
7. **Eligibility certificate:-** Separate eligibility certificate of each and every player of the team issued by the school in which the player is studying as a regular students and should have the signature and seal of Head of the institution.
8. **AADHAAR CARD:** As per guidelines of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, India, and SGFI, online linkage of AADHAAR for each participant of the National School Games at the time of online entries is now mandatory. From session 2023-24 onwards, please ensure to accept the eligibility form as mentioned, along with DOB and AADHAAR documents. The DOBs of the participants on the AADHAAR and school certificates should be the same.
9. **Birth Certificate:** A separate photocopy of the birth certificate of each and every player of the team, duly attested by the Head of the institution is required. Only the birth certificate issued by the Statistic Department of the State, UT, Central Govt., Municipal, or Corporation Form-5 Panchayat shall be acceptable as per S. G. F. I. direction. Sports merit and participation certificates will be verified at the venue.
10. **Girls Team:** The girls team from each district should be accompanied by at least two lady teachers as in-charge who will take care of the girls and will have to stay with the girls during the tournament. They will be responsible for safety and security of girls troop during the tournament.
11. The whole expenditure on TA/DA for the numbers of players district-wise in this tournament will be borne by the HESSA(Elementary).

The Deputy Director of Elementary Education in Hamirpur, where the state tournaments are being organized, will act as organizing secretary and BEEO-Sujanpur as deputy organizing secretary for the successful organization of U-12 State Level Tournament. They will be responsible for making all necessary arrangements for proper accommodation for the boys and girls players and officials during the tournament. They will make suitable provision for running the common mess at Rs. 100 per day per player and the private school boys and girls at Rs. 100 per day per player. They will hold the meeting of the members of the executive committee of DSSA (Elementary) concerned and will form different committees well in time for the smooth and successful conduct of the tournament. The Deputy Director cum organizing secretary will approach and seek the cooperation and help of the Deputy Commissioner, Superintendent of Police, Chief Medical Officer, and Sub Divisional Magistrate of the concerned district for organizing the tournament in a befitting manner. They will direct the ADPEO of the concerned district to prepare the playing field. The senior PETs of the districts will perform the duties of the general manager of the district contingent and will be responsible for taking proper care of and maintaining the discipline of the players and officials during the state tournament. The team in charge and coaches are fully responsible for looking after the players.

VIPS Chief Guest for the opening and closing ceremonies will be finalized by the Dy. Director Cum Organizing Secretary with the prior permission of the Director of Elementary Education, H.P. All the officials deputed with the district contingent, or OSD, will attend the meeting daily and mark their attendance. The Chief contingent incharge will be fully responsible for the proper care and maintenance of the players and officials during the state tournaments. All the game incharges will provide sufficient time to have rehearsals of March Past for the opening and closing ceremonies. A full contingent will take part in March past. In the event of any instance of indiscipline, the official will be relieved forthwith by informing the Director of Elementary Education for further n/a. The Chief contingent incharges of the district are directed to submit a list of officials deputed to tournaments at the earliest. ADPEO (HQ) is hereby authorized to depute the officials and players for the smooth conduct of state tournaments. The organizing secretary is hereby directed to depute senior PET of the concerned district and PET of concern school to prepare the athletics track & Jump events and the play ground well in advance properly. They will also help OSD in each game for marking field and other activities.
