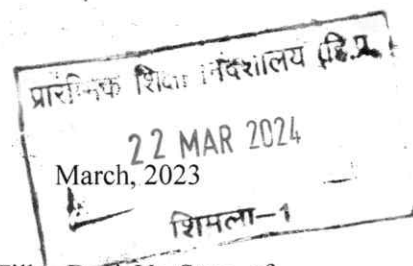

**ORDER**

Whereas, CWP No. 961/2024 titled as Tilka Devi Vs State of H.P. & ors, CWP No. 6941/2023 titled as Gurbhag Singh & ors Vs State of H.P. & ors, CWP No. 7031/2023 titled as Ravinder Kumar & ors Vs State of H.P. & ors, CWP No. 6796/2023 titled as Anjana Thakur & ors Vs State of H.P. ors, CWP No. 7267/2023 titled as Dilbag & ors Vs State of H.P. & ors, CWP No. 7182/2023 titled as Neeraj Kant & ors Vs State of H.P. & ors, CWP No. 6592/2023 titled as Pawan Kumar & ors Vs State of H.P. & ors, CWP No. 10392/2023-Gulshan Vs State of H.P. & ors, CWP No. 10877/2023 titled as Vinod Kumar & ors Vs State of H.P. & ors, CWP No. 6871/2023 titled as Pradeep Kumar & others Vs State of H.P. & ors and CWP No. 7052/2022 titled as Vijay Kumar & ors Vs State of H.P. & ors were filed by the petitioners in the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. for similar relief as is given in CWP No. 342/2021 titled as Yashwant Singh & others Vs State of H.P. & others and in these writ petitions the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. has ordered in different occasions to consider and decide the cases of the petitioners in the light of judgment passed in Yashwant Singh's case.

Whereas, CWP No. 342/2021 titled as Yashwant Singh & others Vs State of H.P. & others alongwith other similar connected CWPs was listed before the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. on dated 31.08.2022 whenafter hearing the matter the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. has passed the following orders:-

**In view of above discussion, the petitions are allowed. Respondents are directed to regularize the petitioners w.e.f. the due date i.e. 01.04.2018 Needless to say that he consequential benefits shall also follow. The petitions are accordingly disposed of so also the miscellaneous pending application(s), if any."**

Whereas, the petitioners in CWP No. 342/2021 titled as Yashwant Singh Vs State of H.P. & Ors and other clubbed matters were also initially engaged as TGT (Arts/NM/Med.) as per the PTA (GIA) Policy, 2006 during the year 2006. Thereafter, the services of the petitioners were taken over on contract basis as per Government notification dated 16.08.2013 in the year of 2015. The services of the petitioner could not be regularized in the year of 2018 as such the matter of appointment of PTA GIA teachers was subjudice in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. Later on, the services of the petitioners were regularized with immediate effect vide this Directorate office order No. EDN-H(2)B(2)-36/2020-PTA regularisation dated 29.08.2020 & 01.09.2020 as per



approval conveyed by the Government vide letter No. EDN-A-Kha(7)06/2012-Loose-I dated 05.08.2020.

Whereas, the services of those teachers who were appointed on contract basis as TGTs in the year of 2015 through direct recruitment and completed 03 years of continuous services on contract basis as on 31.03.2018 were regularized vide office order No. EDN-H(2)B(2)-34/2017-Regularisation (Contract) dated 14.06.2018.

Whereas, in compliance to the order of the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. passed in Yashwant Singh's case, the Government vide letter No. EDUA-E005/4/2023-EDU-A dated 02.09.2023 & 04.12.2023 conveyed the approval to regularize the services of the petitioners in CWP No. 342/2021 titled as Yashwant Singh Vs State of H.P. and clubbed petitions (in this CWP and in Execution petition No. 86/2023) as well as other similarly situated petitioners in other CWPs w.e.f. 01.04.2018. Accordingly, the Department has regularized the services of the petitioners w.e.f. 01.04.2018 vide office order No.EDN-H(2)B(2)342/2021---CC-PTA dated 08.12.2023 and 11.12.2023.

Whereas, after thorough examination of the cases of present petitioners it is found that the petitioners were also initially engaged as TGT (Arts/NM/Medical) as per the PTA (GIA) Policy, 2006 during the year 2006, 2007 and 2008. Thereafter, the services of the petitioners were taken over on contract basis as per Government notification dated 16.08.2013 in the year of 2015. The services of the petitioners were regularized with immediate effect vide this Directorate office order No. EDN-H(2)B(2)-36/2020-PTA regularisation dated 29.08.2020 & 01.09.2020 as per approval conveyed by the Government vide letter No. EDN-A-Kha(7)06/2012-Loose-I dated 05.08.2020.

In view of above facts and circumstances , the cases of the petitioners are similarly situated to Yashwant Singh's case, therefore, in compliance to the order of the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. passed in CWP No. 342/2021 dated 31.08.2022 and further approval conveyed by the Govt. vide letter dated 02-09-2023 & 04.12.2023, the petitioners (TGTs) whose services were regularized vide office order No. EDN-H(2)B(2)-36/2020-PTA regularisation dated 29.08.2020 & 01.09.2020 are hereby considered deemed regularized w.e.f. 01.04.2018 with all consequential benefits:-

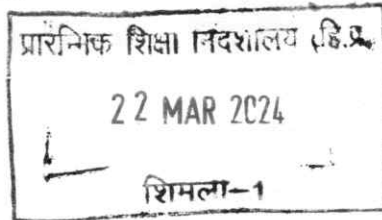

The concerned Principal/Headmaster/Incharge of GSSS/GHS/GMS of H.P. is further directed that consequential benefits regarding monetary benefits to the petitioners shall be released as per the Hon'ble Court orders in Ex. Pet: No. 86/2023 dated 13.09.2023 i.e. 40% of arrears payable according to pre-revised scale may be paid immediately and remaining 60% in two equal annual installments may be paid by 31.12.2024 and 31.12.2025 by calculating difference of pay of the petitioners on the basis of pre-revised scale for the period from 01.04.2018 till the earlier date of regularization by the State. It is further directed that arrear on the basis of revision of pay scale shall be paid, as per instructions issued by the Finance Department H.P. vide letter No. Fin-E-I-C(17)-6/08 dated 07.01.2012 and No. Fin-(PR)B(7)-1/2021-Loose dated 17.09.2022.
