OFFICE ORDER

Whereas, various judgments have been passed by the Hon'ble High Court of HP in numerous CWPs to consider and decide the representations made by the petitioners. After careful consideration of the representations the petitioners are seeking benefits in light of the judgement passed by the Hon'ble High Court of HP in CWP No. 2004/2017 titled as Taj Mohammad Vs State of H.P. & Ors dated 03.08.2023.

Whereas, The operative part of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble High Court of H.P. in CWP No. 2004/2017 titled as Taj Mohammad Vs State of H.P. & Ors dated 03.08.2023 is reproduced as under:-

“Therefore, as the foundation of the order passed by the learned Tribunal, subject matter of these writ petitions, was the judgment of this Court in Narender Singh Naik's case (supra), which judgment itself was based on the Five Judge Bench judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Direct Recruit's case (supra), and as the learned Tribunal rightly held that the services rendered by the original applicants on contract basis were liable to be counted for the purpose of seniority and consequential benefits after their regularization, as the initial appointment of the original applicants on contract basis was after following the procedure prescribed in the Recruitment & Promotion Rules, we do not find any infirmity in the said findings and further as we do not find any merit in the writ petitions, the same are dismissed by upholding the order passed by the learned Tribunal. No order as to costs. Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of.”

The said judgment was assailed by the State Government by way of filing SLP (C) No. 25641-42/2023 before Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. However, the SLP was dismissed by the Hon'ble Apex Court on 04.10.2023. Also the Food & Civil Supply Department thereafter filed review petition before the Hon'ble High Court of HP which was also dismissed by Hon'ble High Court.

And whereas, after perusal of record it is found that the petitioners in the present petitions were initially appointed as TGTs from year 2010 to 2020 on contract basis through Direct Recruitment as per procedure prescribed in Recruitment & Promotion Rules (i.e. through commission, Batchwise, Sports cell, EXM cell & PHH quota). Consequently, their services were regularized as per the Govt. instructions issued from time to time. The period during which petitioners worked on contract basis was not counted for the purpose of seniority and promotions. Hence, the case of the petitioners in the present petitions are similar to CWP No. 2004/2017 titled as Taj Mohammad Vs State of H.P. & Ors decided on 03.08.2023. It is pertinent to mention here that the case of Taj Mohammad has been implemented by the concerned Department.

In view of the facts stated here-in-above and further approval conveyed by the Govt. of HP vide letter No. **EDUC-E05/30/2024-EDU-C** dated 01.11.2024, the contract services rendered by the following TGTs (petitioners) followed by regularizaion is hereby counted for the purpose of seniority subject to final outcome of any legal remedy, if any, exercised by the State. However, no consequential/monetary benefits will be given to the petitioners as the matter regarding consequential benfits is under consideration with State Government. 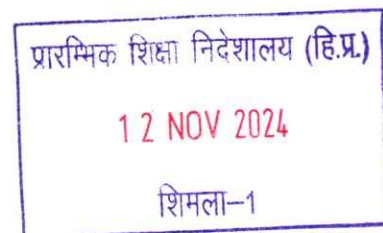
