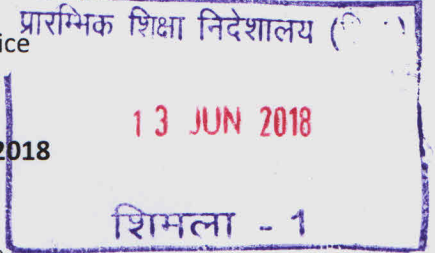

**Subject:-**

Allocation of food grains (Rice) **for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter** (01-07-2018 to 30-09-2018) under the National Programme of Mid Day Meal in Schools (MDMS) for Primary and Upper Primary Schools (Primary 14478.30 quintals & Upper Primary 16280.30 quintals) for the year 2018-19.

Sir/Madam,

The Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Elementary Education & Literacy, Shastri Bhawan New Delhi-110001, vide their letter No. 5 -1 / 2018 – Desk (MDM) of dated 06.06.2018 has conveyed the allocation of foodgrains (rice) for Primary Stage (classes I - V) and Upper Primary Stage (classes VI - VIII) for the **2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter** (01-07-2018 to 30-09-2018) for the financial year 2018-19. In this regard, it is informed that 14478.30 quintals of rice for Primary stage and quintals 16280.30 of rice for Upper Primary stage is being allocated on the basis of enrollement as on 3-09-2017 as per enclosed **ANNEXURE-1**. While lifting the foodgrains (rice), it should be ensured that the best quality foodgrains (rice), which in any case will not be inferior to Fair Average Quality FAQ, is lifted from the PDS Depot. The process followed at the time of receipt of foodgrains (rice) from FCI Depots should be repeated at each level till the foodgrains (rice) reach the end user to ensure that only good quality foodgrains (rice) is delivered for consumption by children. Records /samples regarding quality assurance should be maintained at all levels.

In view of the above, it is requested that distribution of foodgrains (rice) to the Blocks as per norms i.e. 100 gms. Per child per day in respect of Primary classes and 150 gms. Per child per day for Upper Primary classes are made.

**Allocation for tournament: - It is also informed that requirement of rice for preparing Mid Day Meal to the students during Block and District level tournament may be met out from this Allocated rice.**

In addition to this, it should be ensured that rice is also distributed to the newly introduced schools of cantonment Board of Chamba, Kangra, Shimla and Solan District. In this context, it is also informed that the balance of foodgrains (rice) from the previous quarter/ year may be kept in view while allocating foodgrains (rice) to the Blocks for providing Mid Day Meal under MDM Scheme.

Before making allocation the following points may be considered:-

**Enrollment / Beneficiary of Block / institution**


- **Number of school days**
- **Approved norms** 100 gms. Primary classes and 150 gms. For Upper Primary classes per child per day.
- **Unutilized** foodgrains (rice) lying with the school/ Block.
- **(Enrollment/ Beneficiary of Block/ School \* No. of Schools Days in the Quarter/ Month \* approved food norms) - Unutilized foodgrains (rice) lying with the Block/ Schools= Quantity of rice to be allocated to the Block)**
- To ensure the timely supply of foodgrains (rice), allocation of rice to Blocks/ Schools should be made on Quarterly basis instead of monthly basis. **At school level, appropriate record should be maintained and proper receipt should be obtained from the FPS/ PDS holder, indicating the**



quantity of foodgrains received in respect of their schools and make entries in the MDM registers accordingly. This information is also available on website [www.himachal.nic.in/eleedu](http://www.himachal.nic.in/eleedu) of the Department.

- The information in respect of allocation, lifting, utilization and balance of foodgrains (rice) be furnished immediately after the closure of the Quarter as on 30-09-2018 so that further necessary action could be taken accordingly.

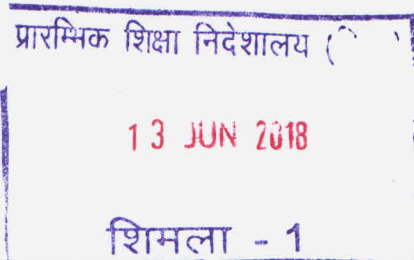

The Block should maintain monthly record of the schools in this regard so as to facilitate the demand of rice to DDEE for the next month. The month wise Lifting and Utilization Certificate in respect of the Foodgrains (Rice) may be obtain from the schools as per specimen certificate attached at Annexure-II.
