ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT FOR THE PERIOD 01.04.2022 TO 31.03.2023 IN RESPECT OF FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT, HIMACHAL PRADESH.

1. INTRODUCTION:

The H.P. Fire Service was provincialised in 1972. Prior to this the Fire Services in the State functioned under the control of various Municipal Committees/ Corporation. During the succeeding years, new Fire Stations, Sub Fire Stations and Fire Posts were opened in the developing townships.

The Himachal Pradesh Fire Fighting Services Act was enacted in the year 1984 and amended in 2000. As per section 15-A of Himachal Pradesh Fire Fighting Services Act, all building plans in respect of buildings more than 15 metres of height, industrial units and commercial establishments dealing with or using explosive and highly inflammable substances require a "No Objection Certificate" from the Fire Department. The NOC is issued by the Fire Services Department through an online Single Window Clearance System after ensuring fire safety measures have been adopted as per National Building Code of India, part-IV 2016. The Himachal Pradesh Fire Fighting Services Uniform Rules were notified in the year, 2005.

2. ORGANIZATION:

The Fire Services Department in Himachal Pradesh is headed by the Director, Fire Services who is assisted by a Chief Fire Officer posted in the Directorate located at Shimla. The Directorate also has a Fire Prevention Wing under a Fire Prevention Officer. This wing is responsible for suggesting fire prevention and protection measures. Each Fire Station/Sub Fire Station is headed by a Station Fire Officer/Sub Fire Officer and each Fire Post is headed by a Leading Fireman and function under overall supervision of a Divisional Fire Officer or Commandant Home Guards of the respective District. The list of 22 Fire Stations, 13 Sub Fire Stations and 45 Fire Posts that have been established in the State may be seen at Appendix-A. These include 04 Fire Post i.e Kelong, Chopal, Shillai and Thunag upgraded to Sub Fire Stations, 06 Sub Fire Stations i.e. Dheera, Bhatiyat, Shahpur, Udaipur, Dharampur, Nerchowk at Rewalsar and 05 Fire Posts i.e. Bhoanj, Jari at Dhunkhara, Nihri, Chirgaon and Atal Tunnel Rohtang South Portal which became functional during the year 2022-23.

3. DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- (i) Director, Fire Services.—The Director, Fire Services, Himachal Pradesh is the appointing and disciplinary authority for all Class-III & IV employees of the Department. He is also the controlling authority for budget under various heads for H.P. Fire Services Department. As per Section 5(1) of Himachal Pradesh Fire Fighting Services Act, 1984, the superintendence and control of the Service is vested in him.
- (ii) Chief Fire Officer.—The Chief Fire Officer, Himachal Pradesh assists the Director, Fire Services in technical and administrative matters pertaining to Fire Services in the State.
- (iii) Divisional Fire Officer/Fire Prevention Officer.— An officer of the rank of Divisional Fire Officer heads the Fire Division, Shimla and Fire Training Centre, Baldeyan, for Administrative and Operational control of Fire Stations and Training Centre under their jurisdiction. One Fire Prevention Officer of the rank of Divisional Fire Officer is posted in the Directorate who is

responsible for suggesting Fire Prevention Measures in order to safeguard public property against fire.

(iv) Station Fire Officer/Sub-Fire Officer/Leading Fireman.--Station Fire Officer/Sub Fire Officer/Leading Fireman posted in the respective Fire Stations/Sub Fire Stations/Fire Posts ensure efficient functioning of the Fire Stations/Sub Fire Stations/Fire Posts.

They are responsible for overall supervision of the Fire Stations/Sub Fire Stations/Fire Posts, which includes attending operational duties and upkeep of fire fighting equipment. They report to Commandant Home Guards/Divisional Fire Officer of the District in which the Fire Stations/Sub Fire Stations/Fire Posts are located.

4. ROLE:

The primary role of the department is to protect life and property from fire and other calamities. However, the other responsibilities inter alia are as under:-

- Issue of fire safety guidelines
- Issue of 'No Objection Certificate' for fire safety
- Fire safety arrangements during public functions
- Issue of Fire Reports
- Organizing fire safety lectures/demonstrations/training/awareness programme in support of Disaster Management in the State.

The Fire Stations/Sub Fire Stations / Fire Posts function round the clock in shifts to provide a prompt response.

5. ESTABLISHMENT:

A total of 1162 posts of Technical Staff and 47 posts of Ministerial Staff of various categories are sanctioned for the H.P. Fire Service Department. As on 31-03-2023, category wise details of these posts are as follow:-

The shortfall in strength of Technical Staff on account of vacant posts as authorized for Fire Stations/ Sub Fire Stations/Fire Posts has been made good by deployment of 592 Fire trained Home

Guards for Fireman duty and 291 Home Guards having heavy vehicle driving license for Drivercum-Pump Operator duty.

In the year 2022-23, 72 posts of Firemen were filled by batch-wise recruitment and 08 posts reserved for ex-servicemen were filled from amonget the ex-servicemen on contract basis, Whereas, the requisition for filling up of 79 posts of Firemen on contract basis by direct recruitment has been sent to the Chairman, Himachal Pradesh Staff Selection Board, Hamirpur.

6. PROCEDURE FOLLOWED IN DECISION MAKING PROCESS:

OPERATIONAL.—During fire fighting and rescue operations, the Officer-in-Charge takes the operational decisions on the spot independently. His work is supervised by the concerned Divisional Fire Officer, Chief Fire Officer, Commandant or Director Fire Services as per requirement.

ADMINSTRATIVE.—All administrative matters are disposed off by the Director Fire Services with the assistance of the Chief Fire Officer.

7. FIRE PREVENTION:

All building plans in respect of buildings more than 15 metres of height, industrial units and commercial establishments dealing with or using explosive and highly inflammable substances and educational institution require a "No Objection Certificate" from the Director of Fire Services or Chief Fire Officer, on the recommendations of Divisional Fire Officer or Station Fire Officer concerned. Accordingly, all such cases are scrutinized by the Fire Prevention Officer posted in the

Fire Prevention Wing at the Directorate. During the year, 2022-23, a total of 2165 NOCs were issued in favour of various Educational Institutions, Commercial establishments and Industrial Units.

The Fire personnel are sent for professional courses/training to National Fire Service College, Nagpur and Regional Training Centres namely Delhi, Chennai, Goa, Kolkata, Guwahati and Bhubaneswar, 07 Sub Fire Officer and 16 Leading Fireman were sponsored for Station Officers & Instructors Course and Sub Officers Course at National Fire Service College, Nagpur as well as Regional Training Centre, Delhi respectively during the year, 2022-23.

14. ACCOMODATION/BUILDING:

At present 22 Fire Stations, 13 Sub Fire Stations, 45 Fire Posts and one State Level Training Centre are functioning in the H.P. Fire Services Department. Out of these Fire Stations, 20 Fire Stations i.e. Rekong-Peo, Rohroo, Mall Road Shimla, Chhota Shimla, Nahan, Bilaspur, Kullu, Dharamshala, Palampur, Hamirpur, Parwanoo, Nalagarh, Una, Solan, Baddi, Manali, Kangra, Mandi, Tilaknagar (Shimla) and Paonta Sahib and 03 Fire Posts i.e. Baijnath, Nurpur and Jaisinghpur are functioning from the departmental buildings. 08 Sub Fire Stations Gohar, Jhandutta, Bangana, Ner Chowk at Rewalsar, Udaypur, Bhatiyat, Chopal, Shillai and 33 Fire Posts i.e. Theog, Amb, Sujanpur Tihra, Banikhet, Shri Naina Devi Ji, Sunni, Churah, Tahliwal, Kala Amb, Arki, Kumarsain, Anni, Kotkhai,Kwar, Banjar, Dada Siba, Dehra,Fatehpur, Banalagi, Bijhari, Jubbal, Salooni, Karsog, Patlikuhal, Sansarpur Terrace, Paddar, Tikker, Sangla, Bhavanagar, Nihri, Jari at Dhunkhara, Bhoranj and Chirgaon are functioning from private buildings. The remaining 02 Fire Stations i.e. Chamba, Rampur, 05 Sub Fire Stations i.e. Dharampur, Dheera, Shahpur, Thunag and Keylong and 09 Fire Posts i.e. Ghumarwin, Joginder Nagar, Sarkaghat, Larji, Kharamukh, Jawalamukhi, Nagrota Bagwan, Jawali and Attal Tunnel South Portal are established in Govt/rent free accommodation.

The Govt. of Himachal Pradesh has notified 02 new Sub Fire Stations i.e. Killar in Distt. Chamba, Kaza in Distt Lahul & Spiti and 01 new Fire Post i.e. Deha in Distt. Shimla which are in the process of being established.

The construction work of departmental buildings for the Fire Stations at Rampur, Sub Fire Station office building at Gohar and Fire Posts office building at Kala Amb, Nagrota Bagwan, Tahliwal, Keylong, Bijhari, Dehra, Dadasiba, Bhavanagar and residential buildings for the staff of Fire Station Mandi, Kangra and Quick Response Team accommodation in Reckong Peo is in progress. 15. REWARDS FOR MERITORIOUS SERVICES:

Sh. Kuldeep singh, Sub Fire Officer was awarded Fire Service Medal for Meritorious Services on the occasion of Independence Day, 2022 and Sh.Nitin Dhiman, Station Fire Officer and Sh. Prem Singh Sub Fire Officer was awarded the Fire Services Medal for Meritorious Services on the occasion of Republic Day, 2023.

16. FIRE FIGHTING & RESCUE OPERATION:

During the year, 2022-23 a total of 4414 Fire Calls and 430 Rescue Calls were received in the Fire Stations, Sub Fire Stations and Fire Posts throughout the State. A total of 159 persons and 143 heads of cattle lost their lives in these fire and other accidents. Estimated property worth Rs. 80,34,62,200/-was destroyed in fire incidents and property estimated to the tune of Rs. 11,99,36,93,000/-was saved. Fire Stations, Sub Fire Stations and Fire Posts promptly responded to the fire/rescue calls and the fire fighting personnel exhibited a high degree of devotion to duty, discipline and diligence in the fire fighting operations and rescue work. The number of Fire and Rescue calls received by each Fire Station, Sub Fire Station and Fire Post during the above period can be seen at Appendix-"D".

18. MELA & VVIPs DUTY:

During the year, 2022-23, Fire Stations/ Sub Fire Stations/Fire Posts staff performed fire prevention duties at the venues of various Melas and VVIPs visits in Himachal Pradesh. The fire personnel provided fire cover at various Helipads in the State at the time of landing and take off by the VVIP/VIP aircraft on 1051 occasions and Mela duty on 66 occasions.

19. MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT:

Based upon the demographic and industrial profile of Himachal Pradesh, 22 Fire Stations, 13 Sub Fire Stations and 45 Fire Posts have been established in the State. These provide services round the clock. Each Fire Station has a complement of 3 to 5 Water Tenders, alongwith other Fire Fighting and Rescue Equipment, whereas, each Fire Post has a complement of one Water Tender and one Quick Response Vehicle, alongwith Fire Fighting and Rescue Equipment. In addition to the above, depending upon the requirement, the Fire Stations/Sub Fire Stations have also been provided with Combined Foam and CO₂ Tenders, Water Bouser, Jeep Fire Engines and Motor Cycles. During the financial year, 2022-23, a total of 10 chassis have been purchased for fabrication of Water Tenders type-B and after fabrication, these fire fighting vehicles have been allocated to the respective Sub Fire Stations and Fire Posts.
