

“ORDER”

A very elaborate consultative process of decision-making, keeping in mind to adopt the precautionary principle and preventive measures in the light of COVID-19, was undertaken at many levels of governance in arriving the decision to stop receipt of cases in the Directorate of Forensics Services, Himachal Pradesh comprising of State FSL, RFSLs (Dharamshala & Mandi) and State FPB, Shimla with immediate effect till 31st March, 2020. This will not be allowed to effect overall disposal of cases which would be covered by putting extra efforts as and when the situation becomes normal. However, examination reports required in urgent cases will be delivered.

2. The scene of crime examination services will continue whenever required by the investigation agencies.
3. All the staff members are advised to use effective masks and sanitizer while performing duties.


