Revised guidelines for disbursement of cash benefit under Janani Suraksha

Yojana in the State of H.P.

Sir,

In supersession of all previous instructions issued on JSY scheme in the state of H.P. regarding the procedure for disbursement of cash benefits under JSY scheme, the following guidelines may henceforth be followed for disbursement of JSY benefits:-

Eligibility:

- 1. BPL women above 19 years of age.
- 2. All SC and ST women.
- 3. All sium dwellers.
- 4. Upto 2 Live births.

Scale of assistance:

Rs. 700 for upto 2 live births.

Disbursement:

At the delivering institution by the delivering institution.

Mode of disbursal:

- Disbursal by the delivering institution only on the receipt by it of a M.ch Card issued by the Health worker of the area of residence of pregnant woman/ concerned Urban RCH health worker in case of slum dwellers.
- Based on the receipt of M.ch card, the delivering institution shall sanction the amount to the account of beneficiary by RTGS in case the details of bank account have been provided immediately on the delivery and before the discharge of the patient from the hospital.
- 3. Where the beneficiary bank account details have not been provided in the M.ch card, the payment shall be made to the beneficiary by way of a **Cheque** against proper receipt.
- 4. In exceptional cases where the beneficiary does not have a bank account and the area of her residence also does not have a bank branch, payment by way of Cash is also permissible. However, this shall be against proper receipt and after recording reasons for making payment by this mode.

- 5. For the purpose of payment to the patient, a Voucher shall be issued under the signatures of treating doctor and ward nurse. Following additional entries in the photocopy of M.ch card will be called a voucher:
 - i) Date of delivery
 - ii) Sex of child : Male / Female
 - iii) Signature of treating Doctor and Nurse
- 6. A JSY nodal officer / official to be designated in every health institution who will be responsible for making the payment to JSY beneficiaries and he / she shall be given an advance from the RKS of the institution on the basis of monthly requirement. RKS will recoup this amount from the NRHM from the office of MOH / BMO.
- 7. The patient / attendant shall present the voucher to the designated JSY officer / official to claim reimbursement.
- 8. Complete record of payments made under this head shall be maintained by the concerned institution.
- 9. M.ch cards will be supplied by the State Headquarter to all the districts and MOH should ensure that they are provided in sufficient number to Health workers.
- 10. Non issue of M.ch cards to eligible beneficiaries by the health workers and non disbursement of timely payments to beneficiaries shall be viewed seriously.
- 11. A suitable reward scheme shall be framed for better performing health workers/ institutions providing timely payment to beneficiaries.
