Terms and Condition for Regularization is as under:-

- 1. The post is temporary but likely to be continued. His regularization to the cadre is subject to review by the Government.
- 2. No TA/DA will be admissible for joining the service at his place of posting unless and otherwise admissible under rules.
- 3. The candidate will have to serve the Department anywhere in HP and he/she may also to serve in difficult area notified, for a minimum period of 3 years.
- 4. The candidate concerned shall have to produce the certificate of his being citizen of India.
- 5. The concerned candidate will have to take an oath of allegiance and faithfulness to the Constitution of India.
- 6. The Candidates' regularization /retention in service is subject to his character and antecedents being found satisfactory through the concerned Head of the Institution within stipulated period of three months.
