- 3. The accounts of the States / grantee Institutions shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971, and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the State(s)/grantee Institutions called upon to do so.
- The payment of grant sanctioned above is recurring and may be debited to the above sub-head under intimation to this Department and the Finance Department of concerned States. Component-wise amount is shown in the Annexure.
- The payment of grant sanctioned above is provisional and is subject to adjustment on the basis of audited figures of expenditure in terms of Ministry of Finance letter No.2 (19)P.II/60 dated 09.10.1964.
- A monthly report on the progress of the Scheme, both financial and physical, may be furnished to the Directorate of Economics and Statistics, New Delhi, regularly by 5th of every month.
- 7. In terms of provisions of Rule 86 of GFR 2017 and in pursuance of OM No.PAO/Sectt./Agri/PFMS/2017-18/381-402 dated 12.11.2018 that all the grantee institutions shall submit Utilization Certificate on PFMS. The Further use of Grants-in-aid being released by the above said Sanction order, is to be done through EAT module of PFMS. The Utilization Certificate not supported by the EAT module data is likely to be rejected and expenditure is not to be treated as regular. The agency would be forced to refund the amount received as the expenditure not appearing in EAT module data is not to be taken as expenditure incurred in accordance with the terms and conditions of the above said Sanction Order.
- This issues in exercise of the delegated powers in consultation with Finance Division of the Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers vide their Dy.No.1308/AS&FA/2019-20 dated 09.07.2019
- 9. This sanction has been noted at Serial No.1/45 in the Register of Grants as per GFR 234 of GFR.
