"The expenditure is debitable under the Major Head-3601-Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major head); 08- other transfer/Grants to State (Sub-Major Head);08.108 Road; 01.00.35 Grants for Creation of Capital Assets corresponding to Demand No. 86 of the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for the year 2023-24".
- 9. The accounts of the funds shall be audited by the Office of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India at such intervals as may be specified by it.
- 10. Compliance of the provision of OM F. No. 12(13)-B/2022 dated 25.05.2022 issued by the Budget Division, Department of Economic Affairs, Ministry of Finance, has been ensured.
