- 7. The State Govt. of Himachal Pradesh is also required to furnish the completion Reports/certificate duly verified by the Audit as and when the work is completed.
- 8. "The expenditure is debitable under the Major Head-3601-Grants-in-

aid to State Governments (Major head); 08- other transfer/Grants to State (Sub-Major Head); 08.108 - Grants from Central Road and infrastructure fund (Minor Head); 01- Grant for State Roads; 01.00.35 - Grants for Creation of Capital Assets corresponding to Demand No. 86 of the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways for the year 2024-25".

- 9. The accounts of the fund shall be audited by the office of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India at such intervals as may be specified by it.
- 10. Compliance of the provisions of OM F. No. 12(13)-B (W&A)/2020 dated 25.05.2022 issued by the Budget Division Development of Economic Ministry of Finance, has been ensured.
