Subject: - Expenditure on SOEs "Office Expenses" and "Other Charges" in March 2016.

Sir,

It has been observed that many Drawing and Disbursing Officers make purchases at the close of financial year, especially in second fortnight of March from SOEs "Office Expenses" and "Other Charges". These purchases, in most of the cases, are effected with a view to consume allocated budget rather than necessity.

In order to ensure proper financial discipline and to avoid last minute purchases, it has been decided that no expenditure shall be allowed out of these two SOEs for any purchases made after 20.03.2016. The only exception shall be in respect of expenditure to be incurred on clearing of pending Water, Electricity and Telephone charges, MR, TE & TTA & Petrol bills. However, these instructions would not apply on expenses to be incurred under Externally Aided Project(s) and Centrally Sponsored Scheme(s).

You are, therefore, requested to issue necessary instructions to all DDOs of your department for strict compliance.
