Subject: Release of fifth installment of grants-in-aid to the State of Himachal Pradesh for implementation of Supplementary Nutrition Programme (SC Component) for 3rd Quarter during 2016-17- reg. Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President to the payment of Rs.2,96,14,000/- (Rupees Two crore ninety six akh and fourteen thousand only) as fifth instalment of grants-in-aid during 2016-17 towards GOI's share for implementation of Supplementary Nutrition Programme for 3rd quarter of 2016-17 under the ICDS Scheme to the State of Himachal Pradesh.

- ICDS is Centrally Sponsored Scheme in which the Centre and States/UTs both have contributions. In the above release, the Centre and States contributions have been calculated on 90:10 ratio and the sanction of funds is subject to the following conditions:
 - i. the amount of grant will have to be utilized for all the components under the Scheme as per the schematic norms;
 - ii. the States/UTs shall also be required to contribute adequate amount for implementation of the ICDS Scheme.
- The sanction of funds is also contingent upon States/UTs ensuring eprocurement of goods and services under ICDS Scheme. The advisory in this regard has already been issued to all States/UTs vide circular No.19-37/2015-CD-I dated 09.07.2015.
- The expenditure is debitable to the `3601"-Grants-in-aid to State Governments (Major Head); 02-Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub Major Head), 02.789- Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes (Minor Head), 24ntegrated Child Development Services (ICDS), 24 00.31-Grants-in-aid General (Plan) under Demand No. 97 of the Ministry of Women & Child Development for the year 2016-17.
- The amount of grant-in-aid is finally adjustable in the books of the Principal Pay and Accounts Office, Ministry of Women & Child Development, D, Wing, Ground Floor, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi. The payment of the State would be arranged through the Reserve Bank of India, Nagpur. The State Accountant General will send intimation regarding receipt of grant-in-aid to the Principal Pay & Accounts Office, Ministry of Women & Child Development, Shastri Bhawan, D Wing, Ground Floor,
- 6. The States shall maintain separate accounts and Turnish information on expenditure incurred on supplementary nutrition every quarter. The information on on the control of Women's Child I

expenditure on supplementary nutrition from 1st April to 30th June must be furnished by 15th July and for the period from 1st July to 30th September by 15th October and from the period from 1st October to 31st December by 15th January and from 1st January to 31st March by 15th April to enable the Department to work out the entitlement of Central assistance of each State Government/UT Administration.
