Staff salary was approved as per date of appointment. PAB did not approve grant for Innovative Project due to non-submission of a detailed proposal for the same.
- [ii] As approved by PAB, non-recurring grant for 8 District Child Protection Units (DCPUs) and recurring grant for 12 DCPUs for 12 months of 2016-17 have been provided as per ICPS norms. Staff salary for these 12 DCPUs has been approved as per date of appointment. Sponsorship and Foster care fund for all 12 DCPUs has also been provided for 2016-17.
- [iii] As approved by PAB, recurring grant for State Adoption Resource Agency (SARA) has been provided for 12 months of 2016-17 as per ICPS norms. Staff salary was approved as per date of appointment.
- [iv] As approved by PAB, recurring grant for 1 existing NGO run Specialized Adoption Agency (SAA) including salary of staff, have been provided for complete year 2016-17. PAB also approved non-recurring grant for 1 existing NGO run SAA as the same was released during 2011-12. (List attached)

[v] Government run Homes

PAB approved non-recurring grant for up-gradation of facilities for 8 Homes and recurring grant for the existing 10 Homes (9 Children's Home and 1 Observation Home) as per ICPS norms, for which grant was released during 2015-16, as per actual number of beneficiaries for complete financial year 2016-17. (List attached)

NGO run Homes

PAB approved non-recurring grant for up-gradation of facilities for 11 existing Homes and recurring grant for 15 existing Homes as per actual number of beneficiaries and as per ICPS norms for complete financial year 2016-17. Salary for already appointed staff was approved as per actual date of appointment to be provided by the State.

PAB approved entire non-recurring grant and recurring grant for 6 months of 2016-17 as per actual no. of beneficiaries and as per ICPS norms for two additional Children Home at Kullu and Mandi Districts subject to submission of registration certificate under JJ Act. (List attached)

- [vi] As approved by PAB non-recurring and recurring grant for 2 existing Open Shelters has been provided for complete financial year 2016-17 as per ICPS norms. PAB also approved recurring grant for 1 additional Open Shelters at Solan District for 6 months of 2016-17 as per ICPS norms subject to submission of registration certificate under JJ Act (List attached)
- [vii] There are 12 Child Welfare Committees (CWCs). As approved by PAB, recurring grant for 12 existing CWCs have been provided for the complete financial year 2016-17 based on the actual number of sittings as per ICPS norms. Salary for Assistant cum Data Entry Operator was 'in-principle' approved for 6 months w.e.f. October, 2016 or actual date of appointment subject to adjustment. The State has informed that the CWC's meetings are 12 per month. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the Chairperson and members of the CWCs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings.
- [viii] There are 12 Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs). As approved by PAB, recurring grant for 12 existing JJBs have been provided for the complete financial year 2016-17 based on the actual number of sittings as per ICPS norms. Salary for Assistant cum Data Entry Operator was 'in-principle' approved for 6 months w.e.f. October, 2016 or actual date of appointment subject to adjustment. The State has informed that the JJB's meetings are 20 per month. The meeting allowance/honorarium of the members of the JJBs has been calculated on the basis of number of sittings.
- [ix] The Government of Himachal Pradesh shall reflect the amount in the audited statement of accounts together with the necessary Utilization Certificate and Statement of Expenditure in respect of the above grants and submit the same to this Ministry immediately after the close of the current financial year 2016-17.
- [x] It is certified that Rule 209(6) (iii) of GFR, have kept in view at the time of releasing Grant to the State Government.
- [xi] The accounts of all grantee Institutions or Organisations shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG(DPC) Act 1971 and internal audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry or Department, whenever the Institution or Organisation is called upon to do so.
- [xii] It is certified that 'Rule 212(5) is not applicable to this grant'.
