Subject: Release of balance of 1st instalment of Recurring Central Assistance and Food Security Allowance (FSA) during summer vacation as a one time measure due to COVID-19 to Government of Himachal Pradesh under Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM-Poshan) {erstwhile National Programme of Mid Day Meal in schools} for the year 2021-22.

Sir,

I am directed to say that recurring central assistance under Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM-POSHAN) {erstwhile National Programme of Mid Day Meal in schools} is released in two instalments in the ratio of 60:40 on the basis of State Government's Annual Work Plan & Budget 2021-22 (AWP&B), duly approved by the Programme Approval Board (PAB) headed by Secretary, Department of School Education & Literacy. The meetings of PAB were convened from May to August, 2021 to appraise/approve the State Governments AWP&B 2021-22. In order to enable the States/UTs to implement the scheme uninterruptedly, the first instalment is released in two parts i.e. ad-hoc release of recurring Central Assistance @ 25% and balance 35% on receipt of information on the unspent balance from previous year's releases as well as food grain.

2. Accordingly, ad-hoe recurring Central Assistance of **Rs. 2193.98 Lakh (Rupees Twenty One Crore Ninety Three Lakh and Ninety Eight Thousand Only)** was released vide letter of even number dated 27th May, 2021. In the meanwhile, the State's AWP&B 2021-22 has also been approved by PAB, the quantification of Central Assistance (both recurring as well as non-recurring) for 2021-22 has already been approved in the minutes of PAB which have since been circulated.

3. Now, the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh vide their letter No. EDN-C-F(11)1/2011-Pt.IV-L dated 17.12.2021 has informed that it had unspent balance of Rs. 340.30 lakh available with it as on 01.04.2021. The balance 35% of recurring Central Assistance from the first instalment and FSA i.e. Rs. 4096.51 lakh (Rs. 2954.83 lakh for balance of 1st instalment and Rs. 1141.68 lakh for FSA) has become due for release as recurring Central Assistance to Govt. of Himachal Pradesh under PM-POSHAN. The component wise details of release are given on next page:

4.(i) The State Finance Department must release Central Assistance along with the minimum matching contribution of State share to the Education Department or the nodal department for implementation of PM-POSHAN immediately.

(ii) The Education Department or the nodal department for PM-POSHAN must release the Central Assistance as well as State Government's matching contribution to the schools/implementing agencies within a week.

5. The expenditure of Rs. 4096.51 lakh (Rs. 2954.83 lakh for balance of 1st instalment and Rs. 1141.68 lakh for FSA) (Rupees Forty Crore Ninety Six Lakh and Fifty One Thousand Only) will be debited to Demand No.24 - Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments. This amount is to be trifurcated into following heads:

(i) Rs. 2746.30 Lakh (Rs. 1980.92 Lakh for 1st instalment and Rs. 765.38 Lakh for FSA) (Rupees Twenty Seven Crore Forty Six Lakh and Thirty Thousand Only) will be debited to Demand No. 24- Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 06 –Centrally Sponsored Schemes (Sub-Major Head), 101 – Central Assistance/ Share (Minor Head), 10 –National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (Sub Head), 10.00 – (Detailed Head 00), 10.00.31 –Grants-in-aid-General for 2021-22, 3601.06.101.10.00.31.

(ii) Rs. 1124.49 Lakh (Rs. 811.10 Lakh for 1st instalment and Rs. 313.39 Lakh for FSA)
(Rupees Eleven Crore Twenty Four Lakh and Forty Nine Thousand Only) will be debited to Demand No. 24 - Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601 (Major Head) - Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 06 - Centrally Sponsored Schemes (Sub-Major Head), 789 - Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes (Minor Head), 10 - National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (Sub Head), 10.00 - (Detailed Head 00), 10.00.31 - Grants-in-aid-General for 2021-22. 3601.06.789.10.00.31.

(iii) Rs. 225.72 Lakh (Rs. 162.81 Lakh for 1st instalment and Rs. 62.91 Lakh for FSA) (Rupees Two Crore Twenty Five Lakh and Seventy Two Thousand Only) will be debited to Demand No. 24 - Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 06 –Centrally Sponsored Schemes (Sub-Major Head),796 –Tribal Area Sub Plan (Minor Head),10 –National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (Sub Head), 10.00 – (Detailed Head 00), 10.00.31 – Grants-in-aid-General for 2021-22. 3601.06.796.10.00.31

6. Accordingly, I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India to release of Rs. 1124.49 Lakh (Rs. 811.10 Lakh for 1st instalment and Rs. 313.39 Lakh for FSA) (Rupees Eleven Crore Twenty Four Lakh and Forty Nine Thousand Only) to Govt. of Himachal Pradesh as recurring Central Assistance under National Programme of Mid Day Meal in Schools for the year 2021-22.

7. The expenditure of Rs. 1124.49 Lakh (Rs. 811.10 Lakh for 1st instalment and Rs. 313.39 Lakh for FSA) (Rupees Eleven Crore Twenty Four Lakh and Forty Nine Thousand Only) will be debited to Demand No. 24 - Department of School Education & Literacy, 3601 (Major Head) – Grant-in-Aid to State Governments, 06 –Centrally Sponsored Schemes (Sub-Major Head), 789 – Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes (Minor Head), 10 –National Programme of Mid Day Meals in Schools (Sub Head), 10.00 – (Detailed Head 00), 10.00.31 – Grants-in-aid-General for 2021-22. <u>3601.06.789.10.00.31</u>.

[A] <u>COST OF FOODGRAINS</u>;

- District Administration will ensure that every consuming unit maintains a buffer stock of food grains required for a month to avoid disruption due to unforeseen exigencies.
- (ii) The Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution has decided that the food grain would be supplied under PM POSHAN at the National Food Security Act (NFSA) rates viz. Rs.2.00 per kg for wheat and Rs.3.00 per kg for rice instead of Below Poverty Line rates (Rs.4.15 per kg for wheat and Rs.5.65 per Kg for

rice) during the first two quarters of the year 2021-22. It is, therefore, advised that the

payment of food grains to Food Corporation of India may be made at NFSA rates in respect of the food grains lifted by the State. District administration will ensure the payment of the bills raised by FCI within 20 days of the submission of bills as per the

guidelines issued by this Department vide letter No. 1-15/2009-Desk(MDM) dated 10.2.2011. The taxes if any levied by the State/UT would be borne by the Govt. of India.

- (iii) State Government will nominate an officer who will be responsible for receiving the bills submitted by FCI and ensuring payment to it in time. FCI will intimate its account number and mode of receiving of payment to the nodal officer, who should be made responsible for transferring money/depositing cheque in that account. State Govt. will ensure timely payment to FCI by district authority.
- (iv) All other provisions made in the above guidelines issued should be strictly complied.

- (v) The States/UTs may evolve a system for on-line payment to FCl to avoid delay.
- (vi) The information on month-wise payment to FCI may be made available to this Department on regular basis.

[B] COOKING COST:

- (i) State/UT's norm of expenditure towards cooking cost shall under no circumstances be fixed at a level less than Rs.4.97 per child per school day for primary stage and Rs.7.45 per child per school day for upper primary stage and Special Training Centers (STC) schools.
- State Government should release 10% minimum mandatory State Share of cooking cost simultaneously.
- States/UTs will not reduce its own budgetary allocation for cooked PM POSHAN below the level of BE: 2005-06.
- (iv) As stipulated in the MDM Guidelines, 2006 [para 3.3(iv)], States/UTs shall ensure that a minimum of one-month's requirement of cooking cost is available in each school as advance through-out 2021-22.
- (v) The States/UTs may evolve online transfer of funds to schools/implementing agencies.

[C] TRANSPORTATION COST:

(i) The admissibility of transportation assistance for 10 Special Category States has been revised to the rate prevalent under the public Distribution System (PDS) in these States/UTs viz. Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim, Tripura and Uttarakhand in place of the earlier assistance at a flat rate of Rs. 125/- per quintal vide order No. 1-1/2009-Desk(MDM) dated 24.11.2009 effective from 1.12.2009. The utilisation of this grant should be commensurate with the actual quantity of food grains lifted and transported under the Scheme. Requirement of Transportation cost may vary from district to district within State/UT depending upon the topography and distance to be transported. States/UTs may therefore, reallocate this grant amongst the districts as per the requirement and as per State/UT norms.

[D] HONORARIUM TO COOKS-CUM-HELPERS

- (i) State Govt. must also release minimum matching contribution of Rs. 100/- per cook-cum-helper as State's share without any delay so that minimum amount of honorarium of Rs.1000/- per month per cook-cum-helper is paid through etransfer in to their bank account. The States may top up their share for releasing more than Rs. 1000/- per month per cook-cum-helper.
- State Govt. may give priority to weaker section of the society like women, SC/ST, OBC, Minorities in engaging the cook-cum-helpers.
- (iii) The cook-cum-helper should be engaged purely on part time basis. Central Govt, will not bear any past service liability in respect of cook-cum-helper.
- (iv) Separate account will be maintained by the State Government for the Central assistance being released under each category (Primary and Upper Primary) separately to meet the payment of cook-cum-helpers under the Scheme.

[E] <u>MME:</u>

(i) Central assistance will be utilized for Management, Monitoring and Evaluation (MME) i.e. 2.7% of total recurring Central Assistance i.e. (a) Cost of food grains, (b) cooking cost, (c) transport assistance & (d) honorarium to cook-cum-helpers as per the guidelines issued by this Ministry's letter No. 1-15/2009-Desk (MDM), dated 14.03.2019.

[F] <u>GENERAL</u>

The grant shall be subject to the following conditions:

- (i) It shall be utilized only for undertaking activities proposed in the Annual Work Plan & Budget for the year 2021-22 and subject to the approval of the Programme Approval Board, and by the Government of India on the basic norms of expenditure.
- (ii) The assets, if any, acquired wholly or substantially out of this grant, should not, without the prior sanction of the Government of India, be disposed off, encumbered or utilized for purposes other than those for which the grant has been sanctioned.
- (iii) The grantee shall maintain a separate and proper account of the expenditure incurred out of the grant and the accounts so maintained shall be open to audit by the Comptroller & Auditor General of India or any authority deputed by him for the purpose as per rules.
- (iv) The State Government shall contribute and release their minimum mandatory share simultaneously to implementing agencies.
- (v) The grantee shall furnish this Department with item-wise statement of expenditure on a quarterly basis and other reports on physical and financial progress in the prescribed formats. The grantee will also submit annual progress within one month from the close of the financial year. The unspent balance, if any shall be taken into account before funds of subsequent years are released.
- (vi) The grantee shall follow strictly all the instructions issued by the Govt. of India from time to time with regard to the implementation of the Scheme and the funds earmarked for Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes Sub Plan. Therefore, the funds are required to be further bifurcated into these minor budget heads i.e. for SCs and STs.
- (vii) FSA (equivalent to cooking cost component) has been/being paid though Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) as one time special major keeping in view the pandemic situation. The State Govt. is also required to release the corresponding State share.

8. It is certified that the pattern of assistance under the Scheme has the prior approval of Ministry of Finance. It is also certified that the grant is being released in conformity with rules and principles of the Scheme.

9. The utilization certificate of this grant may be submitted to Govt. of India within three months of the next financial year. No utilization certificate is pending against PM POSHAN, in any scheme provisional utilization certificate for the year 2020-21 has already been issued.

The accounts of the grantee shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority 10. and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act 1971 and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the Ministry of Education, Department of School Education and Literacy, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.

On receipt of sanction letter, the Principal Accounts Officer may issue an advice to the Reserve Bank of India (Central Accounts Section), Nagpur for affording credit to the balance of the State Government. The Principal Accounts Officer may forward a copy of the advice to the Accountant General and Finance Department of the State Government along with a copy to undersigned in the Department of School Education & Literacy. State Government shall send intimation regarding receipt of grant-in-aid to Principal Accounts Officer, Ministry of Education, Department of School Education & Literacy, Shastri Bhawan, New Delhi-110115.
